Building Readiness

All buildings will receive new welcome signs, hand-sanitizing signs, and hand sanitizer dispensers. You will also see temporary “No visitor” signs all outside the main entrance of each building.

Inside the building, you will see signs reminding everyone to maintain 6' social distancing, as well as "Please wait here" signs outside each nurse's office. Blue lines have been added to the hallway floors to keep traffic flowing in one direction.

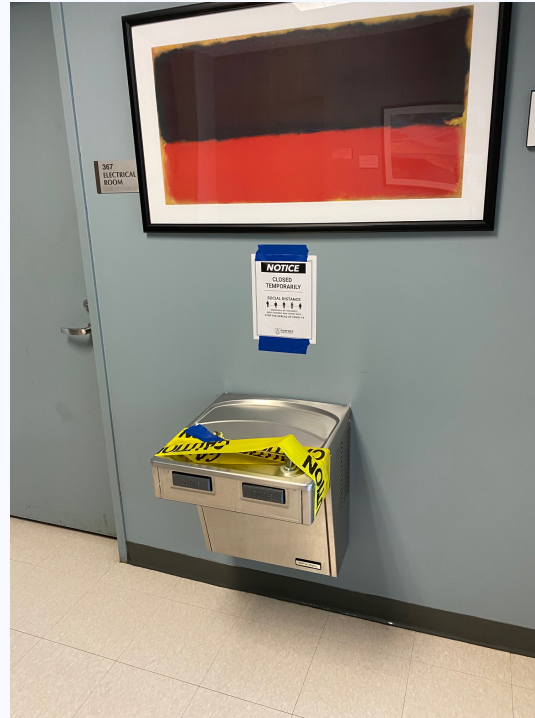
Building Readiness

In the bathrooms, urinals and sinks have been closed in the same manner with signs and yellow caution tape. The water will be left on so custodians can continue to clean and prime the drain traps to avoid having sewer gas enter buildings.

“Temporarily closed” signs have been added above water fountains, and the fountains have yellow caution tape placed over them.

Cafeterias will also have 6' markings to keep social distancing while waiting in line. We are asking building administrators to evaluate lunch lines, and if needed, ask students to sit first and be sent to line up to ensure appropriate distancing.

Classrooms have been set-up so that each student desk has a 6' circle around it to allow for social distancing. Any items such as bookshelves, table, and filing cabinets that need to be removed to allow for the required space has been moved to the gym or other identified areas within each school.
