NOTICE OF ANNUAL TOWN BUDGET MEETING
TOWN OF ELLINGTON
May 11, 2010

Electors and citizens qualified to vote in Town Meetings are hereby notified that the Annual Town Budget Meeting of the Town of Ellington will be held on Tuesday, May 11, 2010 at 8:00 p.m., prevailing time, at the Ellington High School, 37 Maple Street, to consider the following:

1. Discontinuance of portions of the following town roads:

GREEN STREET - from a point 125 feet south along Green Street from the northeast corner of land of CT Heritage Homes, Inc., (Assessor's map #129-127-0000) at land of Michael and Karen Damico, (Assessor's map #129-031-0000), southerly to its south end at land now or formerly of David and Claire Decker (Assessor's map #129-005-0000);

KEENEY STREET - from a line between the southeast corner of land now or formerly of Alice Safranek, (Assessor's map #129-033-0000), and the southwest corner of land now or formerly of Michael and Karen Damico, (Assessor's map #129-031-0000), southerly to its end within land of CT Heritage Homes, Inc., (Assessor's map #129-027-0000).

2. A \$64,900 additional appropriation from 2009-10 Undesignated General Fund Balance to the Town Hall 810 Account for Oil Tank Removal/Boiler Conversion.

3. Entering into a four-year lease agreement for the purchase of Board of Education Computer Equipment in an amount not to exceed \$263,000.

4. Entering into a five-year lease agreement for the purchase of a John Deere front end loader with accessories for the Department of Public Works in an amount not to exceed \$178,000.

5. Adoption of the the 5-year road reconstruction/overlay repair plan, as recommended by the Director of Public Works, and pursuant to CGS Sec. 13a-99.

6. Acceptance of prepaid grants and funds fully reimbursable for the Fiscal Year commencing on July 1, 2010 and ending on June 30, 2011, and to appropriate the same to the Board of Education in a sum not to exceed \$1,402,600, as recommended by the Board of Education.

7. To determine whether municipal tax shall be paid in two (2) installments for real estate and personal property tax in excess of six hundred (600) dollars and motor vehicle tax to be paid in one (1) installment with designated due dates as stated in the Connecticut State Statutes, Sections 12-142, 12-144, 12-144a and Public Act 77-343, Section 2 and to waive any property tax due in an amount less than five dollars as stated in the Connecticut State Statutes, Section 12-144c, as recommended by the Tax Collector.

8. To adjourn the Annual Town Budget Meeting to a referendum to be held on Tuesday, May 18, 2010 from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., with one question:

"Shall the Town of Ellington appropriate, as recommended and as allocated by the Board of Finance, the total sum for all expenditures, a/k/a budget grand total for the Fiscal Year 2010-2011, the sum of \$45,663,569?"
