What Can You Expect in the CDL Model at SRHS?

We recognize that this school year won't be a traditional year. It is likely that we will use three models throughout the school year: Comprehensive Distance, Hybrid, and on-site In-Person Learning. We will begin school in Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL). This decision is based on the priority of maintaining the health and safety of students, staff, and families, during the COVID-19 Pandemic. When we are able to move into Hybrid and/or On-Site Learning, we are prepared to transition quickly and smoothly to either of these models.

School Community

- Students are supported by **SRHS** teachers, counselors, and staff.
- Students are connected to our school identity and culture.
- Students and families have access to support for social emotional well-being of students.
 - School counselors and our social worker
 - Advisory and the DBT Anxiety Support Group
- Students and families can access a system of support to obtain resources (school supplies, access to internet, food).

Relationships

- Students, families and teachers work as a team in support of learning.
- Learning opportunities and teaching are designed and delivered by SRHS teachers.
- Students and families receive timely and ongoing feedback from teachers and school about student progress (attendance, academics).
- Student learning is supported by regular interaction and collaboration amongst classmates.
- Relationships are sustained as we move between implementation models: CDL, Hybrid, On-Site.

Comprehensive Academic Experience

- Student learning occurs five days a week.
- Student attendance and participation is a priority.
- There are multiple pathways to success designed to meet the needs of our diverse student body.
- Students can access SRHS academic programs: IB Diploma Program, IB Career-Related Program, Dual Language, Dual Credit, AVID, and Career Pathways
- There is a balance of synchronous and asynchronous learning.
- Each class is a blend of teacher-facilitated instruction and independent application.
- Individualized ELD, 504, and Special Education Services are provided.
- Report cards and transcripts include A-F grades.
- Teachers use Canvas as the teaching and learning platform for all classes.
