Distance Learning Principles

100% of the weekly schedule is provided by teachers

All subjects are taught, including electives

$\frac{2}{3}$ of the teaching periods online

$\frac{1}{3}$ of the teaching periods offline

Breakdown Examples:

- 30 hours of teaching period = 20 hours online +10h offline
- 32 hours of teaching period = 21 hours online +11h offline
- 34 hours of teaching period = 22 hours online + 12h offline...

First Day of School: September 8th

The start of the new school year has been postponed by one week because teachers are in training.

A PickUp will be organized the week before the start of the school year for the collection of material (all levels) and iPads (MS students only)- Calendar coming soon.

The first 2 hours of the back-to-school day will be dedicated to the explanation by the homeroom teachers on how the distance learning works.

Assessments

While in Distance Learning students are assessed.

During Back to School Meetings, teachers will specify you the assessment methods (nature, frequency, support...).

Evaluations are graded.

Grades will be in the report card.

Weekly students follow up

A weekly monitoring chart is completed by the teachers of each class for all the hours they are in charge of and in each subject.

This table is shared with members of Vie Scolaire who keep track of reported absences and unattended assignments.

In case of recurring difficulties (absenteeism, work not completed or only partially completed) the families are contacted and a plan for the follow-up of the student is set up in partnership with them to ensure success of the student.

STUDENT LEARNING SUPPORT:

Academic Needs



A DEDICATED TEACHING STAFF

- 2 specialized teachers at the primary level (1 francophone, 1 anglophone)
- 1 specialized teacher at the secondary level
- Directors and counselors at the lycée level to advise students in lycée

WITH LEARNING DIFFICULTIES

- Differentiation in the classroom through small groups lessons (every day).
- Pull out or Push in from specialized teachers (one or two times a week)
- In primary “teachers office hours” to help students and parents
- Academic advisory for Lycée Students (on a weekly or monthly basis according to the needs)

STUDENT LEARNING SUPPORT



French Language Support

A DEDICATED TEACHING STAFF

- 2 FLE/Flesco teachers at the primary level (maternelle, Elementaire)
- 3 FLE/Flesco teachers at the secondary level

TO HELP STUDENTS

Based on the needs identified last year and on early assessment

- To reinforce their mastery of the French language
- To give the the tools to be successful in all subjects with an emphasis on language production.
- To provide students with specific linguistic tools

WITH NEED OF REINFORCEMENT IN I FRENCH

- Pull out or Push in (co-teaching) from FLE/Flesco teachers during class time (e.g. during French lessons)
- Regular reading comprehension sessions with librarians (And with parents)
- In *sixième*, LVB (Spanish, German...) is replaced by a reinforcement class in French



STUDENT SUPPORT:

Social Emotional Support

A DEDICATED TEACHING STAFF

- 1 School counselor for the Primary Grades
- 1 School Counselor for the secondary grades
- A “Vie Scolaire” team in secondary

TO HELP STUDENTS

Based on the needs identified last year on early assessment:

- To help students feel connected
- To build connection with new students
- To link SEL with academic topics
- To help students develop a positive self-talk
- To help teachers and students practice self care

TO COPE WITH SOCIAL EMOTIONAL NEEDS

- Training for all teachers at the back to school days
- Working with students on addressing Covid-19 impact
- Intervention, at least once a week in class to present different activities on connectedness, mood check...)
- Work with students individually or in small groups according to needs
- In secondary, “Vie Scolaire” staff will check on a regular basis student assiduity and investment
