

Gifted Endorsement Course

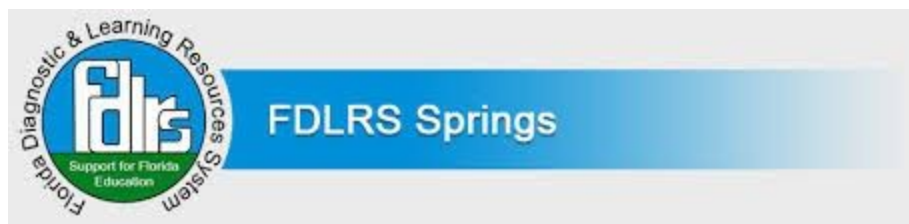
“Gifted: Curriculum and Instructional Strategies for Gifted Students”
