SCHOOL DAY

8:10 a.m. to 3:10 p.m.

HOMEROOM TEACHERS

Provide instruction in math, literacy, and social studies

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT

A counselor, literacy specialist, math specialist, learning specialist, and an educational technology coordinator assist with instruction

SPECIALISTS

Provide instruction in language, science, music, art, PE and wellness, woodshop, technology and digital citizenship, and library skills

ADVISORY

Small, mixed-grade groups (C&Cs) meet monthly with faculty advisors

LEARNING SPACES

Two large homerooms with distinct areas for varied learning activities, a dedicated art studio, woodshop, music classroom, gym, language classrooms, science lab, library, and dynamic playground

CONFERENCES

Three parent-teacher conferences annually, including one student-led conference

RECESS

Twice every day (mid-morning and after lunch)

LUNCH/SNACK

Daily choice of school lunch or bring your own lunch and snacks

TECHNOLOGY

One assigned iPad for each student, plus laptop carts in grades 3-5

FIELD TRIPS

Day trips throughout the year and an annual class trip involving at least one overnight stay for students in grades 2-5

TRADITIONS

Disco Friday, Harvest Festival, Pet & Plant Show, Spring Festival, Friday Community Meetings, and Learning Celebrations

TRANSPORTATION

Catlin Gabel buses, carpool system, and TriMet

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Typically runs from 7:15 a.m.-8:10 a.m. (included in tuition) and 2:50 p.m.-6 p.m.
