Dear Parent/ Carer,

We are really excited to finally opening the school to all students on Thursday September 3rd. Our Year 7 and Year 12 students will have induction days on the 2nd September.

I hope all members of our community have remained healthy and have had a good summer break despite the many disruptions there have been due to the pandemic.

Staff at the school are looking forward to getting back to teaching face to face in classrooms. However, there will be some changes to our usual routines and the structure of the school day. Students will find themselves in year based tutor groups and they will need to go to their allocated outside zone on arriving at school each day. Students will not be allowed inside the buildings until form tutors meet them at 8.25am outside and take them into form rooms. The full curriculum will be taught to all year groups with some adjustments due to restrictions on specialist rooms. At the end of the day, students will be dismissed in five minute intervals starting with Year 7 at 2.25; this will allow them to board buses in year groups.
