



## COVID-19 Specific Restrictions, Information, and Procedures

\*This information overrides the comparable information in the Student-Parent Handbook.

\*\*This information is subject to change as guidance from the Health Department and Widewater School District 3 changes. Please note the revision date for the most up-to-date version.

### Arrival 8:35-8:50:

- No morning recess - students report directly to their classrooms (unless they are having breakfast) via the exterior classroom door or closest main door for interior classrooms.
- Classroom doors will open at 8:35am.
- Car riders - drop students off using the Kiss and Go lane at the south parking lot.
- Students will participate in a variety of morning classroom activities: organizing for the day, morning work, stations, movement activities etc.

### Breakfast:

- Breakfast will be offered from 8:35-8:50.
- Students will enter the building through the main entrance or north entrance by the bus drop-off area.
- Students may pick up and eat breakfast in the cafeteria while maintaining social distancing.

### Lunch:

- Lunch choices will be offered each morning for students selecting school lunch. School lunches will be delivered to the classrooms.
- Students will eat school lunch or their personal packed lunches in the classroom.
- A staff member will monitor lunch in the classroom.

### Recess:

- Recesses will be grouped by class. Classes will not be permitted to intermix during recess.
- Students will have class grouped recess following lunch. The class lunch monitor will also monitor class grouped recess.

### Dismissal 3:30:

- Early student checkout will end at 3:15pm. Families will wait until 3:30pm if they arrive after checkout ends at 3:15pm.
- Students are to go directly to their bus, daycare vehicle, pick up car, or walk home.
- Families waiting outside the classroom door to pick-up their child will need to stand on the blue & yellow paw prints to maintain social distancing.

### Handwashing and Hand Sanitizer:

- Students are required to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer when entering and exiting the classroom. Students may keep a personal hand sanitizer at their seat.



Reusable Water Bottle:

- Students will need a reusable water bottle that is labeled with their name.

Before/After School Activities:

- These activities will not be scheduled at this time.

Masks:

- Students must have their own mask and may not share masks.
- Students are required to wear masks during arrival and dismissal.
- Students are required to wear masks when in common areas.
- Masks must be within the acceptable WSD3 guidelines.
- 3-5 students are required to wear masks in the classroom.
- K-2 students are not required to wear masks in the classroom.
- Staff are required to wear masks in common areas and while interacting with students, staff, or visitors.
- Visitors (ages 11 years and up) on school grounds must wear a mask including on the playground and in pick-up areas.

Assemblies:

- No large group gatherings will be conducted at this time.

Family Nights:

- Family Nights will be scheduled and conducted virtually. More information will be shared prior to each scheduled event.

Classroom Parties:

- No food items will be allowed to be brought in for birthday parties.
- Holiday party details will be shared closer to the event date.

Field Trips:

- No out of school field trips will be scheduled at this time.

Visitors/Volunteers:

- We are limiting visitors/volunteers or non-essential personnel in the building. This includes classroom visits and having lunch with your child.
- Families/visitors needing to talk with staff are requested to do so via phone/email. If visitors must talk to staff in person, masks are required to enter the building and only enter the building through the main entrance. IDs are still required as well.



Fever/Illness:

- If a child has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, or is showing signs of being ill, parents will be required to pick-up their child from school immediately.
- As of the current health department guidelines, any student displaying any one of the symptoms outlined below could be required to be picked up from school immediately. This includes sore throat, runny nose or congestion, muscle or body aches, headache, fatigue, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea.
