



WHAT TO EXPECT

If a Cadet, Faculty or Staff Member Tests Positive for COVID

1 Notification

If a cadet is being tested for COVID, his family will be notified. If test is positive, they will be notified as soon as we receive results. MMA will notify cadets, faculty, staff and parents that there is a positive case.



2 Identification of close contacts



MMA will work with the health department to assess who is a close contact and needs to be quarantined. A close contact is defined as any individual who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 2 days before illness onset (or, if asymptomatic, 2 days prior to positive test) until time patient is quarantined.

3 Isolation for people with COVID-19

If a cadet with positive COVID test lives within a day's drive from MMA, he will quarantine at home for 10 to 14 days or as recommended by the health department. Families may request for their cadet to stay on campus during the quarantine period.

If a cadet with positive COVID test lives farther than a day's drive, he will quarantine on campus for 10 to 14 days or as recommended by the health department.



4 Quarantine of close contacts



Cadets, faculty or staff who are close contacts will quarantine for 10 to 14 days or as recommended by health department. Cadets who live within a day's drive will quarantine at home (families may request for their cadet to quarantine on campus). Cadets who live farther away will quarantine on campus.

5 Return to the corps of cadets

People with COVID-19 may return once they meet all of the following criteria:

- at least 10 days have passed since the date of his or her first positive test and have not had a subsequent illness at minimum (physician orders could be longer)
- at least 72 hours (three full days) have passed since recovery from any symptoms
- obtains notice of release from quarantine from state or local health department
