

Installing the Davis School District Root Certificate

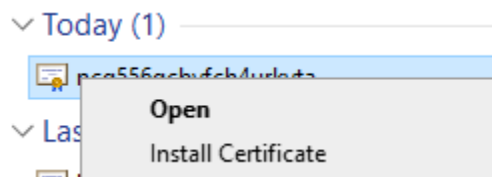
The Davis School District – Root Certificate will allow your device to communicate properly with Davis School District infrastructure devices.

You will first need to download our certificate. it can be obtained at the following location:

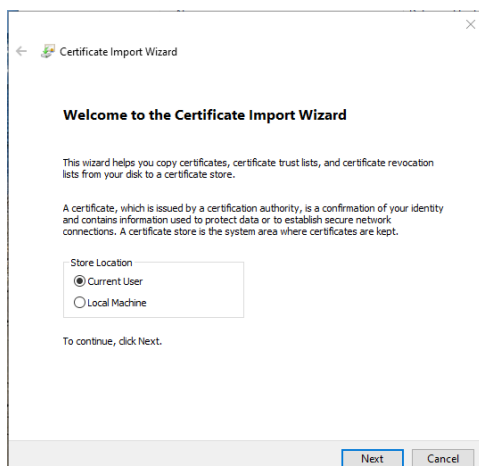

Once you have it downloaded, please browse to the file.

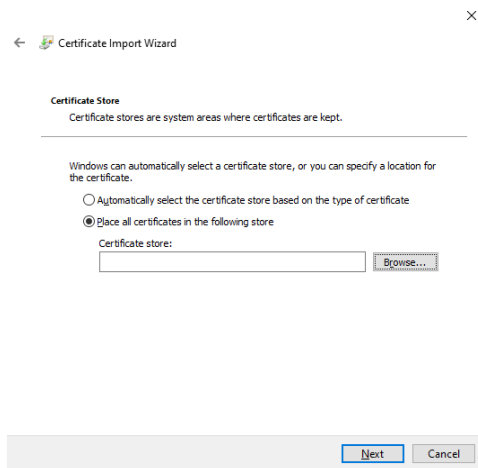
Right Click the certificate file, and click “Install Certificate”



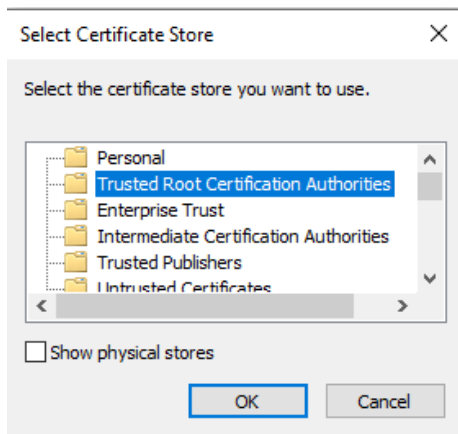
You can import the certificate for either the current user or the local machine. (Local machine will require administrator credentials for the computer). If there will be multiple users signing onto a computer, each user will have to install the certificate if “Current User” is selected.



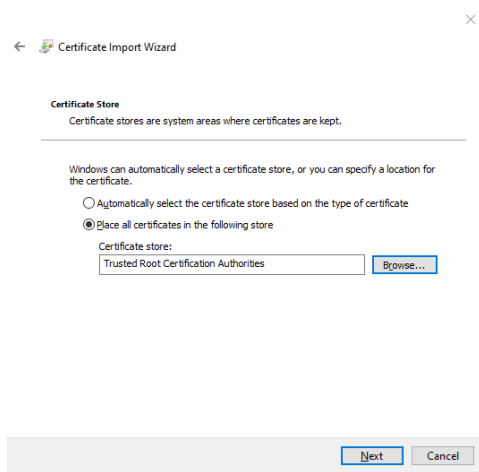
Select "Place all certificates in the following store", then click the "Browse" button.



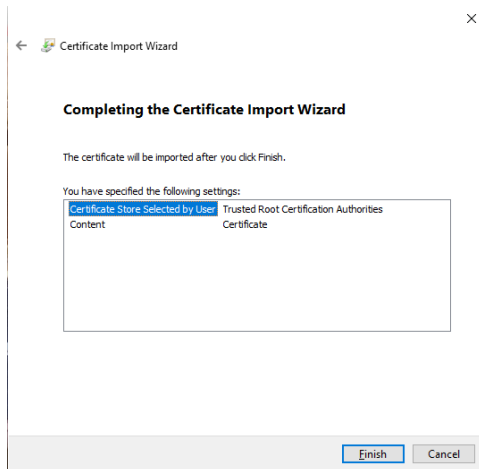
Select "Trusted Root Certification Authorities", and click the "OK" button.



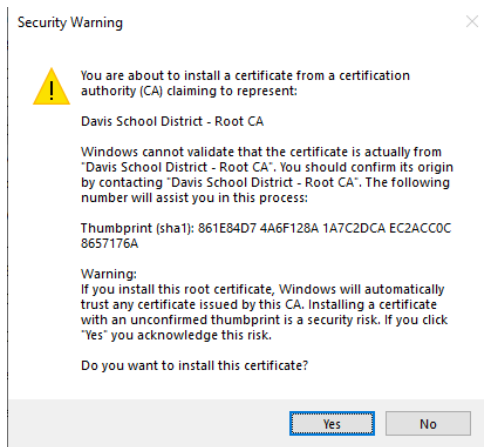
Then Select “Next”



Click the “Finish” button.



Click "Yes" to acknowledge and accept the security warning.
