- Families may also apply for Free or Reduced Lunches by completing an application available on our website at www.esd20.org/for-parents/food-services or at the food delivery bus.
- Any student may purchase Grab & Go Meals - \$1.80 for breakfast and \$3.20 for lunch. Just put money in your ESD20 Keeneeyville Webstore account and you can pick-up food daily. You will also need to provide your student's First and Last Name, Grade, and School.
