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### THE SCHOOL

Established in 1961, Melbourne Central Catholic High School is a Catholic, Diocesan, co-educational college preparatory school for students of varied backgrounds, grades 9-12. AdvancED accredits MCC and the school holds memberships in NCEA, NACAC, and FHSAA.

### STUDENT BODY

Enrollment is approximately 440 students, 79% of whom are Roman Catholic. Thirty five percent of the student body represents siblings and legacies. MCC students come from more than 50 partner schools and 30 different zip codes in Brevard and surrounding counties. We accept students based on grades and a competitive Scholarship/Placement Test.

### FINANCIAL AID 2020-21

60% of students receive financial aid totaling \$1.2 million.

## ACADEMIC PROGRAM

MCC is committed to a comprehensive college preparatory curriculum comprised of over 100 courses in 10 academic areas and includes 19 AP course offerings. Please note that scheduling constraints may impact the number of AP courses that a student can take.

Students must complete 24 credits to graduate, including the following requirements: Theology (4), English (4), Mathematics (4), Science (3), Social Studies (3), World Language (2), Physical Education (1), Fine/Practical Arts (1), and Electives. By graduation, a large majority of seniors exceed the above requirements. Students carry a minimum of seven credits yearly.
