EXTENDED SCHOOL ENRICHMENT LATE START PROGRAM



To enroll in the ESE Late Start program, follow the below steps.

- Go to carmelclayparks.com/ese and click on "Enroll My Child".
- Select "New Parents Open Account" if child hasn't been enrolled in ESE prior to 18/19 school year.
 - If you've enrolled in ESE in the 18/19 school year or later, you will select "Returning Parents Sign In".
- Select register for "ESE Late Start Before School 2020–2021".
- Complete application (steps 1–3) by filling in the required fields indicated in red.
- Submit application (step 4 in process).
- You will receive confirmation once your application has been approved by one of our ESE Site Supervisors. Your child can begin attending after this approval has been received.
