Our team works together to provide social emotional wellness support for students.

SCHOOL COUNSELOR

Addresses academic achievement, personal/social development and college/career development, by collaborating with students, parents, school staff and the community. School counselors are available at district middle and high schools.

SCHOOL NURSE

Provides physical and mental health care, performs screenings and coordinates referrals to healthcare providers. They are qualified to administer psychotropic or psychiatric medications and provide mental health services.

SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKER

Provides evidence-based education, behavior and mental health services to support students. Provides counseling and crisis management services. Promotes a school climate and culture conducive to student learning and teaching excellence. Maximizes access to school-based and community-based resources to support students and families.

SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST

Supports students through administering, interpreting and integrating psychological and educational assessments to determine needs related to learning. Provides special education case management and direct service, mental health counseling and crisis management services that address needs at school and home to help students succeed academically, emotionally and socially. Promotes a school climate and culture conducive to student learning and teaching excellence.

MENTAL HEALTH THERAPIST

Works with families by addressing emotional, behavioral or social issues that may be interfering in a student's ability to be successful in school, at home or in the community. Therapists meet with families to assess an appropriate level of intervention.

CHEMICAL HEALTH COUNSELOR

Supports the well-being of students through creating awareness and providing education on the topic of chemical health. Works directly with students dealing with substance use themselves or in their families, as well as advocates for and connects them with additional outside supports.
