

ST. PATRICK'S RETURN-TO-SCHOOL GUIDELINES AFTER AN ILLNESS

A student returning to school from a fever may do so after being symptom-free without fever-reducing medication (e.g., Motrin/Tylenol) for a full 24 hours.

Likewise, a student returning to school following a diagnosis of Strep Throat or Pink Eye may do so after being on antibiotics for a full 24 hours.

However, all students returning to school after an illness must have their return cleared by the Health Office.
