



## Nerinx Hall A+ Schools Program Agreement

I wish to participate in the A+ Program at Nerinx Hall High School. My parent(s) and I have read the A+ Scholarship Program requirements. We understand and agree to the conditions for eligibility.

**Student Eligibility** In order to be eligible for the financial incentives of the A+ Scholarship Program, Nerinx Hall High School must certify a student as having met all A+ requirements. To be certified for the scholarship, an A+ student must:

- Attend an A+ designated high school for three consecutive years immediately prior to graduation. Students must be enrolled in an A+ school at least 142 days of a school year to be considered an A+ qualifying year.
- Graduate from Nerinx Hall High School with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 grading scale. (Unweighted)
- Graduate from Nerinx Hall High School with a cumulative attendance record of 95% or better.
- Achieve a qualifying score of 17 on the math section of the ACT. Students may also achieve a score of proficient or advanced on the Algebra I end of course exam or a higher level EOC approved end-of-course exam in the field of mathematics:
- Perform 50 hours of unpaid tutoring or mentorship.
- Maintain a record of good citizenship and avoidance of unlawful use of alcohol and drugs.
- To meet the eligibility requirement for good faith effort to secure funding, the student and her parents must: Complete and send in the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA.)

Students must sign this agreement no later than **October 30th** of senior year.

The financial incentives available through the A+ Program is contingent upon the availability of state funds.

It is the responsibility of the student/parent to be aware of the requirements of the program and the status of the student towards successful A+ certification.
