

TRA Uniform Policy  
Approved by School Life Committee May 2020

**PLEASE read each item carefully. This is also posted on our TRA website.**

- \* **All uniform items must be purchased from Land's End except khaki / navy shorts and pants. Pants and shorts ONLY may be purchased from the school uniform section of the following vendors: Land's End, Target, Wal - Mart, Old Navy or Gap. Jackets may also be purchased from the TRA Rebel Store.**
- Any dress code violation will be addressed by administration.
- Clothing must be neat, clean, size and length appropriate. No exposure of under garments, back or midriff areas, or cleavage.
- \* Skorts and skirts must be no more than 3 inches above the knee.
- \* Any item of outerwear (coats, jackets, sweaters) may be worn to school and on the playground, but any outerwear (coats, jackets, sweaters) entering the classroom or worn in the hallways **MUST** be from Land's End uniform vendor or the TRA Rebel Store.
- \* The Land's End or TRA Spirit Store sweatshirts with the school TR logo are the only approved uniform sweatshirts.
- NO hoodies allowed except on specified dress down days.
- Shirts for boys must be tucked in, and belts (solid black or brown only) must be worn. (grades 1 - 12)
- Undershirts / camisoles must be tucked in and must be solid red, white, or navy with no writing.
- \* Tights, leggings, and socks must be solid red, white, navy, or black.
- \* Shoes must be flat heeled. **Shoes must be black or brown leather, suede, or athletic shoes with white, black, gray, navy, or red as the primary color.** Oxfords are acceptable for girls. Sandals must also be the above listed colors. **NO rubber shoes, plastic shoes, or house shoes.** Administration has the final discretion on suitability of shoes.
- All shoes must be properly worn, and shoes intended to have laces may not be worn without laces or untied. Shoe laces should match the uniform or should be neutral in color. No bright colored laces.
- No earrings or body piercings on males. Females must have no body piercing other than conventional ear piercing on the lower lobe of the ear.

- Hats, caps, scarves, bandanas, toboggans, or other headgear are not acceptable for wearing inside the building.
- Hair accessories may be worn by female students and may be purchased from any vendor, but must be red, white, navy, or the school plaid.
- Non prescription glasses and novelty contacts are not permitted.
- Extreme types of haircuts and colors are not permitted. Hair color must not deviate beyond the normal ranges of natural hair color.
- Male students' hair must not hang below the collar, touch the eyebrow, or extend below the middle of the ear.
- Male students must not have facial hair and must be clean shaven each day.
- Clothing must be properly sized. Form fitting tops are not accepted. Pants, skirts, skorts, and tops must overlap enough to avoid exposing the midriff when normal movement such as stooping, stretching, etc., occur.
- Boys' shirts must be long enough to tuck in.
- Tattoos, or body art of any kind, are discouraged and will not be visible during school hours or at school functions. Male students are not allowed to wear nail polish.
- Spirit wear days will be announced by administration periodically throughout the year. On these designated days, students will be allowed to wear TRA spirit wear and uniform bottoms. TRA caps are allowed but must be worn properly.
- Dress down days for our school - wide charity will be announced on specific dates throughout the year. Jeans may be worn on these days. They must be in good condition and traditionally cut. (no low-rise, hip huggers, tight or form fitting pants, spandex, sweatpants, or wind pants, etc.). Boys should tuck in shirts and wear a belt. Footwear requirements must be met. Shorts must be regular uniform shorts. Caps are allowed but must be worn properly. Hoodies are allowed on dress down days ONLY.
- Students are not required to wear their school uniform to extracurricular events such as ballgames, carnivals, fund raisers, etc., unless otherwise specified in advance by administration or sponsor. Students are required to dress in a manner consistent with the principles of the dress code. Spirit day guidelines are acceptable. No inappropriate graphics or wording are allowed. TRA administration will make the final determination on the appropriateness of any clothing, accessories, hairstyles, and colors worn to school or any school - sponsored event.
