## **ACCESSING STUDENT SUPPORT IN A HYBRID MODEL**

We are so excited to welcome you back to school! Our appointments and offices may look different with new protocols due to COVID, we are working hard to ensure a safe environment for all students and staff. We are here for you, we are here to meet the needs of our students and families. To ensure safety with social distancing in our spaces, we are requiring students to have an appointment to access our student support services in both East (Counselors, Social Workers, College and Career Resource Center) and in South (Dean of Students).

To make this easier for students and families, we have set up an online appointment scheduling system called **Acuity**. Acuity Scheduler will provide a seamless and direct platform for scheduling an appointment with your counselor/social worker/dean. Here is the link to reach all student support staff and the link for a virtual meeting through Zoom; you'll also receive an email with the link for the Zoom meeting. If you are enrolled in Hybrid learning and are in the building, show confirmation/email to your teacher and come directly to Student Center East or South for your in-person appointment.

If you are experiencing an emergency/crisis (non-covid/non-health related) while in school, please see the protocol to access our Social Workers in East immediately.

## **COUNSELORS**

To ensure safety with social distancing in our spaces, we are requiring students to have an appointment to access our student support services. To make this easier for students and families, we are using Acuity which will allow our students and families to schedule their own appointments. <u>Use this link</u> to reach all student support staff; after making your appointment, you will receive both a confirmation page and an email with a link for the Zoom meeting. If you are enrolled in Hybrid learning and are in the building, show confirmation/email to your teacher and come directly to Student Center East for your in-person appointment. Student Center East will have one ENTER door (on the North end by the CRC) and one EXIT door (on the South end of the Student Center East). Please watch for signage to assist you. While in our offices, please maintain social distancing with students and staff, keep your face covering on at all times, and use the sanitation station upon entering.

## **SOCIAL WORKERS**

Social Workers at EPHS provide services to students to enhance their emotional well-being and improve their academic performance. For example, students access social workers to discuss emotional instability, difficulty concentrating, family or peer concerns or conflicts, requesting additional information around community mental health resources, and basic needs supports i.e. Food/Shelter/clothing. If you are seeking support, contact us, we are here to help!

Social Workers additionally help connect families with supportive resources in the community. Families and students, please feel free to contact Julie Johnson (Student Last Name A-Le) 952-975-8021 or Martine Knothe (Student Last Name Lf-Z) 952-975-8030 to schedule an appointment. Students and families can also schedule an appointment directly using Acuity. If you are enrolled in Hybrid learning and are in the building, show this confirmation/email to your teacher and come directly to Student Center East for your in-person appointment. If you schedule an appointment on a day you are not in the building, you will receive a link for a zoom meeting.

If you are in the building, and are seeking immediate support from a social worker. Please feel free to come directly to East for support. This may include acute emotional or behavioral distress that inhibits your ability to function in the classroom, thoughts of self-harm or concerns around the safety of others related to emotional needs.

## **COLLEGE RESOURCE CENTER (CRC)**

The same protocol as the counselors will be followed for appointments in the CRC. You will enter through the Student Center East entrance and exit through the CRC door to the hallway.

College Visits: All fall college visits will be held virtually. You can find out who is scheduled on your SCOIR homepage under 'Upcoming Visits & Office Hours'. To get the link to the meeting you need to register by clicking 'Count Me In'.

If you are online you must send a message to your teacher including the visit confirmation. You will be excused from that class for the duration of the visit. If you are at school, you may come to the CRC by showing your teacher the visit confirmation as your pass. If more students at school are registered than the CRC can accommodate, you will receive special instructions from Ms. McNamara.

## **DEAN OF STUDENTS**

Deans are here to support students with attendance and behavior. We want to make sure you are attending school regularly and developing positive relationships with your classmates, teachers and staff. We work to build problem-solving skills and repair harm when it happens.
