# **In-Person Learning Safety Expectations**

## Entry to Campus

- Masks must be worn over nose and mouth in all areas of campus.
- Students need to enter through the front doors of the building or the back lot gate.
- Please utilize hand sanitizer stands at both of these locations.

## On Campus

- Students will be required to walk on the right side at all times, this includes the breezeway, hallways, and stairwells.
- Please avoid walking in large groups while moving around campus.
- Students will not be allowed to congregate in common areas; students need to move directly from class to class.

## On Campus

- Aqua stairwell nearest to the elevator and wellness office will be UP ONLY.
- The stairwell at the end of the Aqua hallway will be DOWN ONLY.
- The hallway from lower green to white has been narrowed due to construction, avoid this hallway if all possible.
- Students will be required to scan their student IDs when entering and exiting the library.

## In the Classroom

- Masks must be worn at all times!
- Each teacher will communicate their individual classroom sanitation procedures.
- Do not move around the room and keep distance between you and other classmates.
- Ask permission before approaching the teacher or his/her space.

# Restrooms

- Restrooms are limited to 4 people at a time.
- Maintain social distancing while waiting to use the restroom.
- Only use the open stalls and sinks.
- Auditorium restrooms will be available for use.

## Lunch Time

- Stand on the blue tape while waiting in the lunch line.
- Only sit on seats marked with blue tape to maintain social distancing.
- Masks may only be removed when actively eating or drinking.
- Students may eat along the breezeway or in the courtyard.



## Lunch Time

- **THERE WILL BE NO LUNCH VENDORS ALLOWED!**
- Parents are NOT permitted to drop off food to the front office.
- If a student forgets their lunch, they can purchase a meal in the cafeteria.
- Students are not allowed to leave campus during lunch.
- During lunch today you will need to pick up your ID in the cafeteria. ID cards will be required this year to purchase a lunch.

## **Guthrie Students**

- **Students will attend classes at the Guthrie Center on Mondays.**
- **Guthrie students are allowed to utilize any open space on campus to access their online classes.**
- **Students will not be allowed to congregating in any areas on campus.**
- **Masks must be worn at all times.**

## End of the Day

- Students must leave campus at the end of the day if they are not attending tutorials.
- No students will be allowed to congregate on campus.
- Masks must be worn while waiting for transportation.

# Mask Violations

Masks	Consequence
Warning (Reminder)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A verbal warning is given to the student. A mask is issued, if needed. If the student complies, the issue is resolved.</li></ul>
1st Offense (Insubordination)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If student refuses to wear a mask, the incident escalates to “insubordination”.</li><li>• The student is referred to the grade level assistant principal.</li><li>• The parent is contacted, due to a safety concern, and a 1-day out-of-school suspension is recommended.</li></ul>
2nd Offense (Insubordination)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Verbal warning is given to the student. A mask is issued, if needed.</li><li>• If student refuses to wear a mask, the incident escalates to “insubordination.”</li><li>• The student is referred to the grade level assistant principal.</li><li>• The parent is contacted, due to a safety concern, and a 3-day out-of-school suspension is recommended.</li><li>• A parent in-person conference takes place, prior to student returning.</li></ul>
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense (Persistent Misbehavior)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The student is referred to distance learning setting for the remaining grading period.</li></ul>
