However, if you have private insurance, your child is eligible to remain on your insurance as long as you hold a policy under IL Insurance Code (215 ILCS 5/356b, 215 ILCS 5/367b, 215 ILCS 125/4-9.1, 215 ILCS 165/15a).</p>	<p>PARENTS: Need to call their insurance company and ask to complete a statement of disability for their dependent child. This will allow your child to remain on your insurance past their exit from school.</p> <p>SCHOOL: Provide any documentation that is requested with a release of information.</p>
