The School's agreement

The school will:

- ensure that your son / daughter is well taught and that he / she achieves his / her best in all aspects of school life;
- provide a balanced recovery curriculum and meet his / her individual needs;
- help him / her to develop a sense of responsibility and to be considerate of others;
- keep you informed about general school matters and his / her progress in particular;
- be welcoming at all times and offer you opportunities to become involved in the daily life of the school when deemed safe to do so;
- treat your son / daughter fairly and care for their well-being

The parent's or guardian's agreement

I / we will:

- see that my son / daughter comes to school every day (unless there is a legitimate reason for absence such as displaying COVID-related symptoms), on time and with everything he / she needs;
- let the school know about any concerns or problems which might affect his / her work or behaviour;
- support him / her with reading, homework or any other home learning activity;
- attend parent interview days and discussions about his / her progress;
- encourage him / her to join in after school activities which interest him / her;
- support school policies and rules and the code of behaviour, including all those linked to coronavirus;
- convey support for the school by respecting the building, staff and environment by behaving appropriately whilst on the school site;
- allow the school to share information about my child with external agencies as necessary;

Dropping off and collection:

- drop my son / daughter off within the allocated time;
- obey the one-way system on the driveway;
- keep an appropriate distance from other parents and guardians;
- leave the school premises and surrounding areas promptly, not gathering with other parents;

The school office:

- only come to the school office if absolutely necessary, recognising that most enquiries could be made via email or telephone
- if a visit to the office is required, only enter the waiting area one at a time;
- queue outside at an acceptable social distance;

The child in school

- provide my child with a water bottle that they will bring into school and take home each afternoon to clean and fill ready for the next day;
- encourage my child to continue social distancing within school, follow all behaviour principles to ensure safety and practise good hygiene routines
- ensure my child is wearing clean uniform
- follow the government guidance for face covering (recognising that this is not needed in primary school)



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Experiencing illness

l will

- not send my child to school if they are displaying COVID-related symptoms
- ensure that I report any absence stating the reason
- collect my child promptly if the school contact me to say the child is showing symptoms compatible with coronavirus;
- undertake appropriate testing and isolate as advised

The pupil's agreement

I will:

- attend school every day (unless there is a legitimate reason for absence such as displaying COVID-related symptoms), and arrive on time;
- make sure I bring everything I need for my lessons;
- wear the correct school uniform and be tidy in appearance;
- make it as easy as possible for everyone to learn and for the teachers to teach;
- act with consideration at all times
- look after my school property and keep the school clean and tidy;
- do all my class work and any homework set;
- be in the right place at the right time;
- maintain good levels of hygiene, washing and sanitising hands regularly;
- move around the school following the one-way system;
- socialise at school during breaks and lunchtimes in a mindful manner;
- maintain social distance where possible;
- behave in a respectful way, doing all I can to keep my environment safe
