AP World Languages, AP Seminar and AP Research (register by 11/6)	\$145 per exam

**Students must enroll with Total Registration AND the College Board.** Students enrolled in an AP class at Paly should have signed up already with the College Board during class. Students must sign up with the College Board **AND** Total Registration.

**Students NOT Enrolled in an AP Class at Paly:** Students interested in taking an AP exam that are not enrolled in the class, must first sign up with Total Registration to find the appropriate join code. When signing up on Total Registration, sign up with “No Teacher.” After signing up with Total Registration, sign up with the College Board using “Exam Only.” Questions? **Special Notes About AP Chinese:** Due to capacity constraints, ALL students registering for the AP Chinese exam will automatically be waitlisted. PALY students enrolled in our AP Chinese class have first priority, followed by PALY students not enrolled in the course by grade level seniority.

**Capacity & Staffing Limitations:** Due to capacity limitations, some students can expect to test on the late-testing dates. Late Tests will be administered May 18-21. You will be notified of your testing date.

**You cannot take two tests at the same time, and PALY will decide which test you take first.** For example, *Chemistry and Spanish Literature & Culture*. You'll take one of them as a "Late Test." Late Tests will be administered May 18-21. No extra fee is charged for schedule conflicts. Certain conflicts will incur a \$40 late testing exam fee. **Free or Reduced Fees:** Students who have a verifiable financial need are eligible for reduced fees. Please obtain a financial assistance form from your Guidance Counselor (need counselor signature) and bring completed form to the ASB bookkeeper.

**Testing with Accommodations:** January 15 is the final day to submit a request for testing accommodations to the College Board. Work with your Guidance Counselor or Case Manager to submit a request, if necessary. If you are already approved by the College Board for accommodations, you do not need to refile. Please note that the request process can take seven weeks and does not begin until all required documentation is received.
