

### Kindergarten Supplies

- School backpack (**BIG** enough for transporting large projects, iPad, and pencil box of supplies daily between home and school) preferably with no buckles.

- pencil box (plastic, approx. 8" x 6" x 2")
- two sturdy folders with two pockets (one should be **plastic**)
- 12 **wood case** pencils (#2) – **sharpened**
- one box of **Crayola** crayons (24 count)
- one box (8 or 10 count) of **Crayola Broad Line** washable markers (**classic colors**)
- one box (24 count) of **Crayola** colored pencils
- one set of **Bold Crayola** water colors
- two bottles of **Elmer's** School Glue (4 oz - no gel please)
- two large **Elmer's** glue sticks (1.27 oz)
- covered pencil sharpener
- two erasers (i.e. Paper Mate Pink Pearl)
- two **yellow** highlighters
- one pair of Fiskars scissors (not plastic)
- two Expo black markers
- one **clean, old sock** for whiteboard eraser (**not an eraser**)
- one box of facial tissue
- Clorox wipes
- paint shirt (an adult t-shirt works the best)
- non-marking, rubber-soled shoes
- wired earbuds for iPad ( 3.5mm straight jack)
- one box of sandwich size Ziploc bags - **girls only**
- one box of gallon size Ziploc bags - **boys only**

### Suggested Additional Items

- individually packaged facial tissue (several packs for your child)
- blank paper to have on hand at home for distance learning activities when needed
- one reusable, refillable, personal water bottle for student to keep at desk
- lanyard for mask (available at Target)

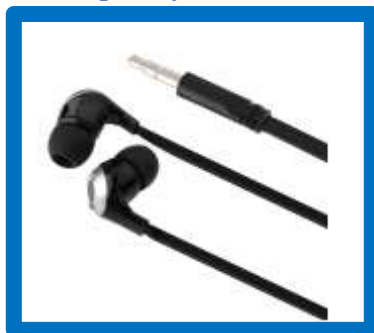
*In some instances, we are recommending specific brand names due to the fact that some school supplies hold up better and last longer than others. (Example: Elmer's School Glue).*

**Fourth Grade Supplies**

- one plastic **YELLOW** folder
- one composition notebooks – college ruled
- one bottle of Elmer's glue
- two **JUMBO** glue sticks
- one ruler (both centimeters and inches)
- one scissors
- two rolls of tape on disposable dispenser
- one **LARGE** box of facial tissue
- one **LARGE** container of disinfecting wipes
- one stylus to use with iPads
