


A DAY IN 6TH GRADE


KEITHLEY CAMPUS

 - 400 Hall, Gym location of electives



"PASSING TIME"


The 4 minutes you have to get to your next scheduled class!




Remember: You won't be in the same class all day anymore! You will have "passing time" to ensure that you make it to your next class on time!
