



Re-Opening of School During COVID-19 Pandemic

Expectations for Students

#1 RULE – Follow ALL health and safety procedures and policies established by the school AND ALWAYS follow the instruction of a Saint John's faculty/staff member.

IN-SCHOOL LEARNING

- Only report to school on days reserved for your cohort (Green or Gold).
- Do NOT come to school if you are feeling unwell. Be honest with yourself, your parents, and during the morning arrival screening process.
- Report immediately to first period (A/D) after successfully being screened at morning arrival.
- Wear a mask at ALL times, unless allowed to remove them during a designated “mask break” or eating in the Viking Café.
- Be sure to wash hands or use hand sanitizer frequently.
- DO NOT congregate in hallways during passing times. Keep moving to the next class. Students should walk single-file on the right side of the hallways and follow directional arrows and tape on floors.
- DO NOT move desks in classrooms. All students will have assigned seats. All desks should be wiped down at the end of class.
- DO NOT share food, personal belongings (clothes, masks, shoes, etc.), or school materials (ex: books, pens, computer, earbuds, etc.)
- Read and follow all directions indicated by the signage around the school (where to sit and stand in Viking Café, sinks/stalls to use in bathroom, etc.)
- Be in uniform.
- Bathroom use will be limited.
- No eating in school other than in the Viking Café.
- Water bottle use is permitted throughout the day. Masks should be moved up or down on the face, but not taken off completely.
- Keep your health and the health of others in high regard. Take this situation seriously.
- Be respectful and patient of the teachers, realizing they are also teaching several students at home.

- At the end of the school day, follow dismissal procedures by promptly exiting the building or reporting to the designated and supervised area of the school for athletics or the extended school day room. There should not be any gathering inside or outside the school at dismissal.

ONLINE LEARNING

- Find a quiet, appropriate learning space.
- Attend ALL “live” instruction sessions (via Zoom or other platforms). BE ON TIME. Attendance will be taken.
- Be seated at a desk/table during these “live” instructional sessions.
- Use your real, full name when logging onto Zoom or other learning platform.
- Remain muted during “live” instruction, and raise your hand (or use a “reaction” when you have a question or comment).
- Always keep video feature turned on so the teacher can see you during all “live” instruction.
- Be respectful and patient of the teachers, realizing they are also teaching several students in person while you are at home.
- If needed, make use of teacher office hours on Fridays.
