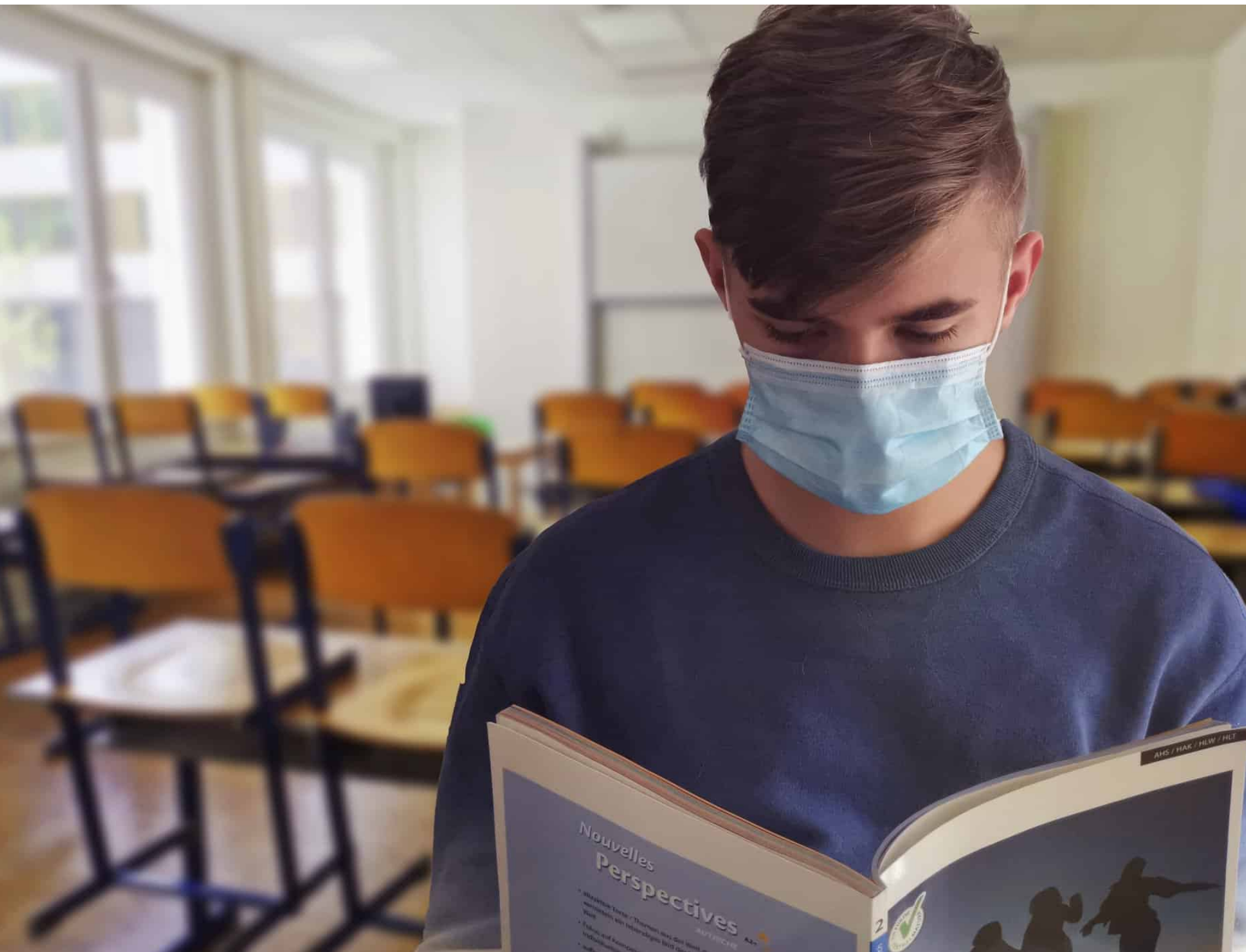




PPE DISTRIBUTION PLAN



PPE Item:	Distribution Plan:
Cloth masks	2 for each staff person not receiving a window mask (see below)
Cloth window masks: <i>Update since 9/1 email: 3 different brands of window masks, with ear loops + Badger Shield Plus.</i>	2 masks with clear windows for each staff person in the following buildings/rooms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wing Lake ● DHH ● Self-contained rooms (ARP, FRP, DHH, PREP, SEED) ● Ancillary staff ● K-3 classrooms ● Bus drivers transporting DHH students ● Early on ● Elementary reading recovery and paraeducators ● BHHS World Language American Sign Language staff ● Bloomin'
Disposable masks, box of 50 individually wrapped, medical office style	1 box for each: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Classroom ● Office/reception counter/desk
Disposable window masks	1 box for each of the following classrooms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wing Lake ● DHH ● Self-contained rooms (ARP, FRP, DHH, PREP, SEED) ● Ancillary staff ● K-3 classrooms ● Early on ● Elementary reading recovery rooms ● BHHS World Language American Sign Language classroom ● Bloomin'
Desk shield	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 moveable, tri-fold plexi-glass shield for each classroom teacher ● 1 freestanding plexi-glass shield for primary contact staff, i.e. receptionist, food services, attendance, etc.
Gloves, box of 100	1 box for each classroom & main offices throughout the district
Hand sanitizer, refillable bottles ("Symmetry" Foaming, Fragrance free w/aloe and vitamin E, 62% Alcohol)	2 bottles for each classroom Note: A gallon of sanitizer will be provided to each building for refilling.
Hand sanitizing stations	Each identified entrance (knowing certain entrances will remain locked)
Disinfectant spray ("Betco Green Earth")	1 bottle for each classroom Note: Meets EPA criteria for use against SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19, non-irritating no harsh fumes for the user or space occupants, can be used as a food contact sanitizer with

	no rinsing or wiping required.
Paper towels	2 rolls for each classroom
Disinfectant wipes	1 container for each classroom
Washable gowns	1 gown for each staff person in the following buildings/rooms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wing Lake • DHH • Self-contained rooms: ARP, FRP, PREP, SEED
Disposable gowns	1 box for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each Wing Lake classroom • DHH rooms • Self-contained rooms: ARP, FRP, PREP, SEED
Full face shields	1 for each staff person at: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wing Lake • DHH • Self-contained rooms; ARP, FRP, PREP, SEED • Ancillary staff (in each building; speech, social workers, OT/PT, psychologists)
Thermometer, touchless	Distributed as necessary
Pulse Ox	2 for Wing Lake
N95 Masks	Wing Lake & ADA accommodations
Signage	Each building is receiving the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bathroom washing hand decals • Mask wearing decals for doors/entry • Floor social distancing decals <p>NOTE: PPS will be coordinating placement of all signage to ensure consistency across the district.</p>
Air purifiers	1 in each nurse's lounge for the quarantine room Notes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plan to have building subs, 2 per building, staff the quarantine room. • Nurses will train the subs.
Drinking Water	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The water fountains in the buildings will be disabled. • The water bottle filling stations will be functioning.
Tents	It appears the majority of tents will be installed by September 14th since planning review and permitting is wrapping up.
