February minutes approved as posted

1. Miscellaneous Business
 - a. Council Membership – Added Sara Reed to membership saraareed@yahoo.com
 - b. Kara Kol enthusiastically volunteered to be the Parent President this year
2. SIP goal reviewed
 - a. Goal #1 for 2020-2021 is that 65% of students in grades K-3 will show typical or higher progress on the EOY Acadience Reading Pathways to Progress.
 - b. Goal #2 is that 80% of students in grades K-6 will demonstrate proficiency at 80% or higher on a grade level common assessment in mathematics.
 - c. Goal #3 is to improve Social Emotional Learning (SEL) skills in students by implementing direct instruction of research based SEL strategies.
 - d. Goal #4 is to implement STEM teaching and learning processes into every classroom to create a comprehensive STEM learning environment for students.
3. Alternate day schedule and school safety
 - a. For safety measures, West Bountiful has recess zones to separate students, requires masks for all who enter the building, assigned lunchroom seating to allow for contact tracing, and times spent together have been shortened (ie: recess)
 - b. For alternate day schedule the council asked if Monday holidays had been taken into consideration. Calendar decisions must be made by the district school board. Parents were informed to contact the board if they had concerns.
 - c. The STS works at two separate schools and is still working to set up the technology in our new school. He will help parents with technology issues they may have at home as soon as he can each day – please be patient.
 - d. Because of HIPA a school wide notification will not be sent out if cases of Covid occur in the school.
 - e. Parents will be notified if contract tracing determines that they need to be.
 - f. Parents do NOT need to provide a doctor's note for students to be allowed back to school if they have been out for sickness.
4. School Updates
 - a. The school is a “rebuild” which means that not all the electronics in the building were replaced. We moved our copiers, printers, etc. We do have some new devices because of the computer refresh money.
 - b. Grass is right now scheduled for the spring. If water can be arranged for when the secondary water is shut off for the season, then it may be sooner.
 - c. Parking lot is scheduled to be finished September 8.

- d. Sidewalks are being completed daily. The one on the West side is scheduled to be completed sometime in October.
 - e. Landscaping is being worked on. Sprinkler pipe is being laid.
 - f. Parents requested that an angle of cement be added to the North West corner of the sidewalk near the catwalk. The council was advised that it would be mentioned at the next construction meeting.
