Year 6 and Year 8 Personal Statement

Year 6 and Year 8 children were today given a paper copy of the personal statement forms to complete by Monday 21st September.

Digital copies are available (on the links above) in case you prefer to complete the form digitally. Completed forms should be given/emailed to form tutors.

Music Activities

Music Practice clubs have already started for this term (please see below for more information).

Individual music teachers will be in school for lessons this term and will be in contact with parents to let them know when lessons will commence.

Junior Manor Singers, which includes all of Years 3 and 4 and runs on Wednesday afternoons during school time will start next week. Sessions will be on a rota basis to follow current guidelines.

Unfortunatley, due to current restrictions, Senior Manor Singers will not be able to run this term but Chamber Choir will run for a limited number of children.

Other smaller music groups and ensembles will recommence during week beginning 14th September. There are fewer spaces in these groups than normal due to current restrictions.

Associated Board Music Exams

This term's Associated Board Music Exams will take place in school on Monday 23rd and Tuesday 24th November. Children who have music lessons outside school are also able to take exams in school.

Parents who wish to arrange an examination in school for their child should complete the form which can be obtained from <u>Jennifer Hustler</u>.

Pupils who take individual lessons in school and are taking an exam this term will have a form sent home by their instrumental teacher.

Forms should be returned to Jen Hustler, Director of Music, by Friday 16th October.

Chess Masterclass

Chess Masterclass will restart on Tuesday 15th September. A rota for the term will be sent home to parents next week.

Year 6 and Year 8 Personal Gum Shields for Children in Years 3 to 8

At Yateley Manor all children in Years 3 upwards must wear a mouth guard/gum shield for playing hockey and rugby.

Boil and fit gum shields are available from sports shops and the School Shop. Some parents prefer to purchase gum shields which are professionally fitted and offer a greater level of protection (not recommended for children in Years 3 and 4 because their teeth change so guickly) and these can be organised though your dentist.

Girls in Year 3 upwards will need gum shields from the start of the year whilst the boys in Year 3 upwards will need them from November. Please note that children without a mouth guard will not be able to represent the school in rugby or hockey teams and will only have limited access to elements of training sessions.

Pre-Prep Choir

Pre Prep Choir for children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 starts on Tuesday, 15th September. Choir takes place in the Fyson Blum Hall each week at 8:10am and is run by Jen Hustler, the Director of Music, and Sarah Newman. The session finishes at 8:40am. The choir is open to children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 but this term, due to current restrictions, we are allowed a maximum of 27 children in the choir.

An email will be sent to parents on Tuesday next week with a form for signing up and places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. We will hold a waiting list in the hope that we will be able to offer more spaces later in the year. We are very sorry for any disappointment this may cause.

Music Practice Club

Music Practice Clubs will be running again this term as an after-school club every evening except Wednesdays. The club is open on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays to all children in Years 3 to 8 and on Tuesdays to children in Years 1 to 8 who learn a musical instrument, whether in or outside school. The purpose of the club is to provide an opportunity for independent practice, taking advantage of the fantastic practice room facilities in the Music School, under the supervision of Mrs Gough, the school violin and piano teacher.

The session is pupil-led, but with Mrs Gough on hand to provide guidance, help with theory, aural or to accompany students working towards a performance.

Any pupil wishing to attend the club should sign up during the day in School Reception. Then come and get your music practice ticked off the list before you get home! Given the current situation if a club is oversubscibed, or if we would be unable to keep children within their bubbles, children may be asked to go to a different club. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

Please ensure that any child who wishes to attend a Practice Club session has their music and instrument (if appropriate) with them. It will not be possible to loan out music or equipment at this time.

The club **will not run** next Friday 11th September.

LAMDA

We will be offering LAMDA tuition to children in Years 3 to 8 again this academic year. During designated early morning and lunchtime sessions, Gail Brundle will be delivering individual, shared and small group lessons in a variety of courses set by the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art, resulting in recognised exam qualifications. While there will be no additional charge for these lessons, there will be a registration fee for any child who wishes to take the exam.

Children who attended sessions last year and were preparing for LAMDA exams which were scheduled for May 2020 will be continuing their sessions this half term and will take their exams in October. Parents will receive an email today confirming sessions.

New groups for the 2020 - 2021 year will start after half term and these are open to all children. Due to restrictions with teacher: pupil ratios there will be a limited number of places available for each session. These will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Parents will be sent an email letting them know when and how to sign their child up.
