PSAT News: Junior and Sophomores Only

IWA has the option to administer the PSAT on campus, provided it is safe to do so from a public health standpoint, to juniors on Wednesday, Oct. 14 and to sophomores on Saturday, Oct. 17. Students will be required to wear a mask and follow social distancing guidelines at all times while on campus, including when testing.

Alternatively, IWA may administer the PSAT **b** sophomores and juniors during the school day on Jan. 26, 2021. The January administration will have the same benefits as the October PSAT/NMSQT, including eligibility for programs

administered by National Merit Scholarship Corporation. *Students may only sit for one exam administration.*

Parents are asked to complete this survey with their preferences by Sept. 25.


