COMPLETE THE FAFSA/CADAA

Complete the FAFSA at [Fafsa.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov). Undocumented youth complete the application at dream.csac.ca.gov

2

FINISH THE CHAFEE APPLICATION

Youth in foster care on or after their 16th birthday may qualify for an additional \$5,000. Apply at chafee.csac.ca.gov

CHECK E-MAIL

Monitor campus deadlines and missing paperwork by reminding youth to check their email frequently.
