## SSM Health's Virtual Visit—\$20

Get diagnosed and treated for common conditions like colds, allergies, coughs, UTI and pink eye. No waiting. No appointment needed. Start a visit 24/7. Complete a questionnaire online and an SSM Health provider will review it within 12 hours to create a treatment plan which may include a Rx sent to your pharmacy and a provider's note.



## Primary Care Provider — \$20 Copay

Contact your PCP for a wide range of preventative and long-term healthcare services. Video visits may also be available.



## Urgent Care —\$20 to \$80 Copay

For urgent, non-life threatening injuries or illnesses. Designed to treat medical problems that cannot wait, like: most broken bones, minor cuts, minor burns, and most drug reactions.



## Emergency Care —\$100 to \$150 Copay

For life threatening injuries or illnesses. Locate your nearest hospital for: choking, trouble breathing, suspected heart attack, serious broken bones, suspected stroke, severe pain, unconsciousness, severe or unusual bleeding, suspected poisoning, prolonged or repeated seizures, or convulsions.
