Age Requirements

The Spring Branch Independent School District offers a half-day educational program for children who reside in our attendance area and will turn three years old on or before September 1, 2020, and a full-day program for children who will turn four years old on or before September 1, 2020.

Eligibility

To be eligible to attend children must meet one of the following Texas Education Agency criteria:

- Limited Proficiency in English
- Economically Disadvantaged (Eligible for free or reduced lunch program)
- Homeless
- Military Family
- Foster Care
- Star of Texas

PK 4 Tuition

All four-year-old children may attend prekindergarten in Spring Branch ISD. The District does not charge tuition for those children who meet one of the eligibility criteria listed above.

For those prekindergarten students who are not eligible in one or more of the categories described above, there is a tuition charge. The tuition is \$595.00 per month payable for nine months. A non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00 will also be collected.

Tuition scholarships are available and will be evaluated individually. Applications are available at the website below.

Transportation

Bus service is provided for four year old full day prekindergarten students.

Parents must provide transportation for three year old prekindergarten students.

Registration

Registration for all new students will be held July 30, August 3-6 and August 10-13 and is on a first come first serve basis as space is available. Spring preregistration will be held April 20-24. Parents may stop by one of our prekindergarten centers listed below to pick up an appointment card for registration in August. Appointment cards may also be picked up at the PK centers on July 27-30 from 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.

The following must be presented to register a child for the program:

- Birth certificate
- Proof of residence in SBISD
- Immunization Records – a list of immunizations required may be found at: www.dshs.texas.gov/immunize/school/child-care-requirements.aspx
- Income verification (2 months' paystubs)
- Parent identification
- Military orders
- Foster Care letter
- Star of Texas Award
