



GUIDELINES FOR HOSTING A STRATFORD EVENT

Under our “new” normal of COVID-19, there are additional restrictions and protocols placed on Stratford and those acting on our behalf for our students. Therefore, anyone hosting an event on behalf of the school, classes, teams, clubs, etc... should follow these guidelines.

- Social distancing practices must be upheld by allowing space of at least six (6) feet between attendees.
- When possible, please make arrangements for events to be held outdoors.
- Appropriate hand washing/hand sanitization must be available.
- Guests (student and adult) must wear masks at all times.
- If food is served, please follow these guidelines:
 - No open food service, food/beverages must be packaged individually in sealed containers.
 - Adults must be responsible for handing out any food/beverages.
 - Masks may be removed for guests to eat, but attendees must be socially distanced while eating.
- With the exception of siblings, students may not ride together for school events.
- Guests should be especially aware of taking and posting photos on social media which may portray an irresponsible attitude towards COVID-19 restrictions.
 - Individuals must have on masks in group photos and/or be socially distanced.
 - Students can receive demerits/disciplinary actions for not following responsible social media practices.
