DISTRIBUTION OF STUDENT CHROMEBOOKS & SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Inquiring minds want to know... When can I pick up my child's Chromebook and school supplies from Hamden Middle School? The time is now; well, actually on Thursday! Please carefully read the following notes to ensure you are ready.

Date: Thursday, September 10, 2020 **Location:** Hamden Middle School **Times:** 8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.

- Parents will visit HMS between 8:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Follow security's directions to drive around the building and along the side of the cafeteria.
- Distribution of Chromebooks and/or School Supplies will go to:
 - All Grade 7 Students
 - Grade 8 Distance Learning Students
 - Grade 8 Students assigned to Hybrid Model Group 2.
 - (Last name begins with L-Z.)
- If your child is in eighth grade and assigned to the Hybrid Model Group 1, we will provide the Chromebook and school supplies on the first day of school.
- Every student will receive a backpack full of school supplies. All seventh grade students will receive
 a Chromebook, and eighth grade students will only get a Chromebook IF they never borrowed one
 from school.
- **-Important Note**: Families must return any Chromebooks borrowed from their elementary schools, in order to receive a new Chromebook and school supplies. Be sure to bring any Chromebooks, textbooks, or school supplies with you on **Thursday**.

Receiving a Chromebook and school supplies is exciting and the next step in preparing for the reopening of school.

A NOTE FROM THE HMS HEALTH OFFICE

Did you know all seventh grade students must have an updated physical with documentation of two vaccines, **MENINGOCOCCAL** and **T-DAP**? It is a state law that students cannot begin school without these vaccines. We are still looking for over 200 incoming seventh grade students to submit their updated

STUDENT SCHEDULES


TIPS TO GAIN ACCESS TO THE PARENT PORTAL

The HPS district code is GJZC.


1.) Visit the Hamden Public Schools website and click on the "I WANT TO" tab.




2.) Click on "Access the Parent Portal."

DISTANCE LEARNING MODEL

Some HMS students have selected the option to learn from home. We understand there are many questions about the Distance Learning Model, and we want to provide students and families with more specific information to help start the year.

CHROMEBOOK & SCHOOL SUPPLY PICK UP: Families should come to school on Thursday, September 10, 2020 to pick up their child's Chromebook and School Supplies. (See article above for more information.)

HMS BELL SCHEDULE:

Students at home will follow the bell schedule. (Bells may not ring in your homes, but we will follow the times outlined below.) Students are required to log into class each period. There are seven classes per day. We also follow an A day, B day schedule. (See below) Some classes are offered each day, such as our Core Classes (i.e. English, Math, Science). Other classes are offered every other day, such as our Encore Classes (i.e. PE, Art, Music). When students and families review their child's schedule, they will be able to identify all classes for the first semester. You will notice there is time between classes for students to log out and into the next class. In addition, there is time for lunch each day.

STUDENT SCHEDULES: Schedules will be published in PowerSchool on Thursday, September 10, 2020. Parents are reminded to register for the Parent Portal as soon as possible. (*Information is provided above.*)

GOOGLE CLASSROOM CODES: Team Leaders will send home information regarding Google Classroom codes by the end of this week. Students will need these codes to log into their Google Classrooms. Students will be a member of a seven or more Google Classrooms. If students are having difficulty logging into their Google Classrooms, please contact the Team Leader or Ms. Coogan.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL: On Tuesday, September 15, 2020, students are expected to follow their schedule and log into Google Classrooms. They should log into their <u>first period</u> class by 8:00 a.m.

ATTENDANCE: Student attendance will be monitored for each of their classes. Attendance data from the first period of the day will be reported to the Connecticut State Department of Education. We strongly believe attendance is essential for student success. Students are expected to report for learning each day.

REPORTING AN ABSENCE: Parents should call the school by 9:00 a.m. to report an absence. Seventh grade families will call 203-407-7207. Eighth grade families will call 203-407-7180. Parents can also email their child's team leader or the school nurse.

MODES OF LEARNING: Our teachers will be responsible for instructing all of their students. Some students will be present in the classroom, and other students will be learning from home. Teachers are planning their units of study and daily lesson plans. When learning from home, students will be exposed to a variety of learning experiences. At times, the teacher may post a pre-recorded mini lesson. The teacher may also use Zoom to have students "live stream" into the classroom. Some learning activities will be independent, and other experiences may require students to work with others through Zoom breakout rooms or Google Hangouts.

We are embracing the following concepts: Passion, Perseverance, and Patience. Our teachers are passionate about their work. They know the importance of connecting with students. They are committed to planning engaging lessons and meeting the needs of all students. We understand there will be challenges. It is a new experience for all! If there are "bumps in the road," we will persevere until we are successful. Finally, we ask all members of our community to be supportive and patient. If your child is having trouble, contact your child's Team Leader or an administrator. We will work together!

SETTING UP YOUR CHILD'S WORK AREA AT HOME

Students will be working from home in both learning models, Hybrid Learning and Distance Learning. It is important to find a quiet, positive work setting. Consider these recommendations:

- Locate a space away from siblings and family pets.
- Set up a clean table or desk near an electrical outlet.
- Be sure there is proper lighting.
- Get headphones or earbuds.
- Organize school supplies in the location.

• Select a neutral background for "zooming" into class, such as a plain wall. Getting ready for the first day of school is important. We need to embrace a positive mindset and get organized.

ASSESSMENTS & GRADING

Students will receive grades for their work during the first marking period. Teachers will be evaluating classwork and assessments. Specific information regarding grading will be shared in future communications. However, it is important to note that we will be returning to the practice of providing grades as a form of communication between school and home.

Distance Learners, you may be home, but <u>you</u> are important members of our school community. We will continue to reach out and celebrate your successes. We intend to challenge you each and every day of school. But, don't worry... we are here to support you in this new journey of learning.

Middle School Athletics Update

At this time, we are pleased to announce our plans to offer a fall sports program at HMS. There are three fall teams, including:

- Boys Soccer Team coached by Mr. Jay Cebula;
- Girls Soccer Team coached by Ms. Nora Crann; and
- Girls Volleyball Team coached by Mr. Jimmy Poulsen.

HMS will follow guidance from the DPH and the CIAC. All teams will practice outdoors, and coaches will focus on skill based training. Teams will not compete against other schools, and there will be no games in our conference.

The program will be offered four days of the week, Monday through Thursday. Students will follow the Hybrid Learning model. Students who are participating in Distance Learning are eligible to participate, but must follow the schedule below:

Our after-school program will begin at 3:00 p.m. and conclude at 4:45 p.m. Student athletes will go home after school and then return to school at 3:00 p.m. Parents must provide transportation to practice, and pick up at the end of practice. Students must dress appropriately for practice and bring a personal water bottle. Please note student athletes will not have access to the locker rooms facilities, and coaches are unable to provide water. It will be essential for student athletes to return to practice with the required items.

Parents who are interested in their child playing a fall sport, must complete the online registration using the link below for FamilyID. An email account is required to create an account on FamilyID. Once you complete the registration, the school nurse will review the necessary medical forms and HMS coaches will check for academic eligibility.
