Hebron Academy's Response to COVID-19

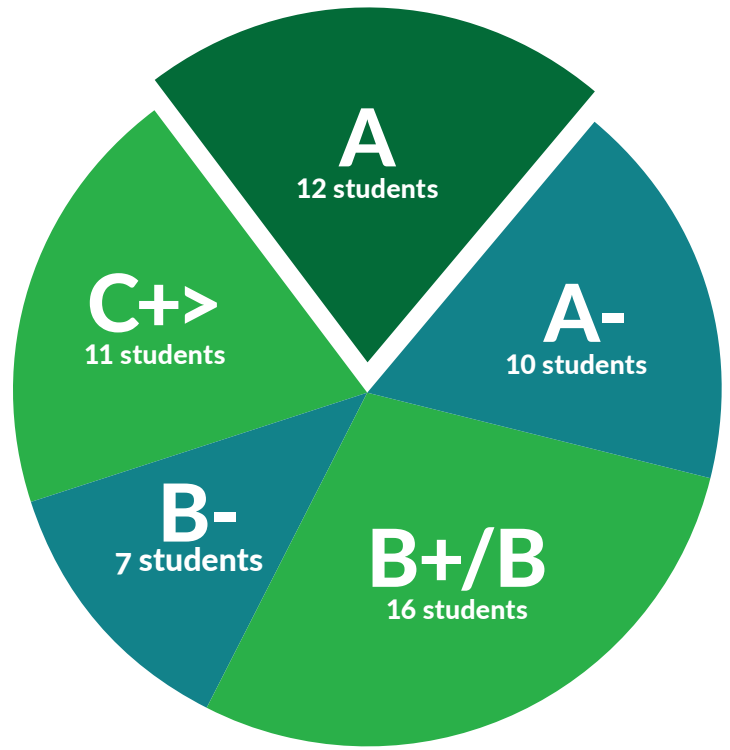
Hebron Academy moved to distance learning in March 2020. Students had complete term grades for the Fall and Winter trimesters, and for the third trimester students had the option of standard grading or Pass/Fail. The final year-end grade for 2019-2020 students was an average of the first two terms unless there was a significant change in Spring trimester performance. We began the 2020-2021 school year in a hybrid model with most students attending class in-person and some attending online synchronously or asynchronously. Class sizes were reduced to allow for social distancing in the classroom, limiting elective options for some students.
