Windsong Trust Scholarship Required Criteria Information Sheet 2020-2021

The following criteria will be used by the Windsong Scholarship Committee when reviewing potential applicants to continue with the process. These criteria have been developed by the Committee to provide a minimum standard for those applicants being considered. Please review them carefully; we believe each one is a critical piece in the ability of possible award recipients to successfully complete the K-12 program of The Meadows School.

Student Criteria

- 5 years old before August 1, 2021 (Recommended age: 5 years old by July 1, 2020)
- Academically ambitious and enthusiastic about learning
- Reading readiness
- Maturity to handle full day Kindergarten schedule
- Ability to understand and speak English fluently
- Must be a U.S. Citizen

Family Criteria

- To be considered for this scholarship the maximum combined household income should not exceed \$110,000 per year.
- Afford incidental costs of enrollment such as:
 - Uniforms (Used uniforms available at a nominal fee.)
 - Lunch (Can either be brought from home or purchased for approximately \$7 per day.)
 - Classroom supplies (Varies depending on classroom activities.)
- Afford monthly tuition payment. (All families will have a financial obligation for tuition based on their income and ability to pay. Payments can be expected to range from \$100 to \$750 per month.)
- Provide transportation to and from school on a timely basis, drop off between 7:40-8:05 a.m. and pick up no later than 3:30 p.m.
- Provide a stable and supportive home environment to oversee daily homework assignments.
- Attend parent meetings and communicate timely with School administration, teachers and staff.
- Support School policies, including dress code.
- Provide documents and other materials required on a timely basis to complete the process. (See below.)
