

Revised Landfill Policy Changes as of 9-11-20

Hours remain the same:

- Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday
- 8 am - 4 pm
- Disposals self-serve only
- Attendants cannot provide assistance

OPEN to the Public (Tues, Thurs, Sat) for the following items:

- Leaves & Yard Waste
- Household trash
- Comingled recyclables only which include:
 - Glass, Plastic, and Metal containers
- Demolition Debris –Wood, Glass, Drywall & Roofing
- Small metal items
- Couches and stuffed furniture (**Fees charged - \$20 per couch/\$10 per chair**)
- Carpet
- Large Appliances (**Fees charged - \$15 for Freon Units**)
- Large Plastic items
- Cardboard
- Electronic Waste - TV's, Computers, Printers,etc.
- Lightbulbs and household batteries
- Propane Tanks (Fees charged - \$2 each tank)

- Mattresses and Boxsprings
(**Now Accepted per the following conditions:**)
 - Free - **If clean and dry.** Resident **must** be able to stack the mattress into the front of the recycling trailer. Attendants cannot provide assistance.

 - If mattress is not clean and dry, you have 2 choices:
 1. Pay \$20 to dispose of it as bulky waste
 2. Free if **disassembled** into cloth, metal & wood sections

- Tires (**Fees Charged - \$3/car \$5/light truck, Other sizes - various fees**)

Contractors - Can go over the scale with construction debris & yard waste

The following items are **NOT** accepted:

- NO Motor Oil at Landfill - **Curbside Pickup Only.** Place One sealed gallon at a time next to your blue bin on recycle week to be picked up by USA Hauling.
