- Instructional Goals for Reading

To improve and strengthen reading skills in the areas of oral reading fluency, comprehension, use of reading strategies, vocabulary development, and written response to text while developing a love for reading

Supporting Your Child in Reading

Ten Ways to Improve Your Child's Reading

1. Set aside a regular time to read to your child everyday (even as your child gets older).
2. Surround your child with a variety of reading material.
3. Have a family reading time.
4. Encourage activities that require reading.
5. Discuss the books and stories your child reads.
6. Help your child think about what he/she is reading and to use reading strategies

Supporting Your Child in Reading

Ten Ways to Improve Your Child's Reading (continued)

6. Help your child think about what he/she is reading and to use reading strategies.
7. Use many ways to read an unfamiliar word.
8. Find new words in books and stories to improve vocabulary development
9. Dear Diary/Journal Writing- Buy your child a notebook and have them use it as a daily journal of his/her life.
10. Support your child in all reading efforts.
