



RESPONSIVE CLASSROOM

- <u>Greeting:</u> eye contact, using names, saying "Good Morning" loud and proud, and choosing a motion (high five, fist bump, etc)
- Morning Meeting: Creating a community in the classroom through interaction and learning about each other
- <u>Interactive Modeling:</u> Modeling the appropriate way to do things, focusing on the positive, for classroom and hallway routines
- Quiet Time: time set aside after recess, may include reading, writing, thinking, etc.
- Closing Circle: Closure to the day dismissed from circle

ASSIGNMENT EXPECTATIONS

- Students are expected to explain their thinking and reasoning rather than just knowing the answers (quality over speed)
- ALL answers should be written in complete, restated sentences
- Any class work that isn't completed during allotted class time becomes HOMEWORK
- Assignments are to be handed in on time. Students will not be able to receive full credit on assignments that are late
- If your child is absent, your child has the same number of days that they were absent to complete any missing assignments

CHROMEBOOK EXPECTATIONS


- Not to be used for social purposes (ex:Google Hangouts)
- Typical use at home 1 hour to complete class work/ homework ONLY
- Students are encouraged to work on their chromebooks in a shared space, such as the living room, and place devices in a shared space when they are done working
- Easier to monitor their usage when in a **shared space**



- Each day students will have
 Math & Science assignments to complete
- <u>Daily Work</u> is posted on this slideshow
- Slideshow is on Google
 Classroom for students to see
 and Class Website for parents
 to see



- Each week students will get an <u>Interactive Notebook</u> on Google Classroom to complete
- Daily assignments will be from various websites- Discovery Education, Brainpop, Newsela, etc.
- Students MUST log in through Classlink
- Turn in slideshow at the end of each week for 1 grade



- Daily math assignments in practice book
- Pre-test will be given each unit to help determine students' needs
- Khan Academy for exit tickets and extra practice
- Saavas ("textbook" website) can be accessed through Classlink
- Small group time will be used for extra assistance or enrichment

ACADEMY

- Used for extra practice and quick checks of student understanding of topics
- Not graded- not on report card
- Excellent resource for preparing for tests and quizzes



- Excellent resource for nonfiction reading & current events
- Used for Science
- Kid friendly articles written in different reading levels
- Each article has comprehension questions to show understanding

DISCOVERY EDUCATION

- Your child's Science "Textbook"
- Used for watching videos, reading articles, completing interactive labs, and interactive experiments
- Work from this site will be linked on <u>Science Interactive</u> <u>Notebooks</u>



- Targets your child's math needs
- Pre-test determines any gaps in learning that your child may have
- Challenges students that need above grade level practice
- Used for extra practice, not graded



- Used for PARCC Practice & Benchmarks
- Used throughout the school year for homework and extra practice
- Targeted skill practice
