Attendance

Students are REQUIRED to attend Closing Circle at 12:40 each day. They are to rejoin using the same link for morning meeting.

Remote Learning Expectations

- Students should eat breakfast and get dressed (no pajamas) before the start of the school day.
- Find a quiet workspace (not their bed), free from distractions.
- Gather needed supplies in advance.
- Be on time for all classes.
- Stay muted with camera on.
- Work will be assigned through google classroom.
- When asked to take a picture of their work students must make sure the picture is clear and legible in order to get credit.
- Students will need independent reading books.
- Children are responsible for attending all virtual meetings. This includes small groups and whole group meetings and any special area classes.

Chromebook Care

- Now that we are remote, it is extremely important that your child cares for their chromebook.
- Please make sure chromebooks are charged daily.
- Please make sure chromebooks are out of the way of spills or food.
- Please make sure chromebooks are on a solid surface and do not fall or get damaged.

- Reading: Making Meaning
 - New program this year that includes read aloud components, vocabulary component, and independent reading time (IDR)
 - o Students will be expected to read for AT LEAST 30 minutes each afternoon
 - Reading Log Form MUST BE COMPLETED DAILY!
- Writing: Collaborative Classroom
 - New program this year that includes read alouds, learning about authors, independent writing time
- Math: Investigations
 - Same program that includes teacher guided learning, inquiry learning, and practice

Assignments

- Students should check daily slides for assignments.
- Students should **read** and **follow** the directions on each assignment.
- Students should be working until the end of the school day.
 - The work your child does during the afternoon (1:55-3:30) will count towards your child's overall academic grade. Your child is responsible for completing their assignments independently and turning them in on time.
- Students should make every effort to complete their assignments by 3:30.
 - O In the event they need more time, parents MUST email me with details regarding the assignment that will be submitted late.
 - I will only accept assignments one day late for partial credit.
- Work should always be in complete sentences and checked for errors by student.

Afternoon Assignments

READING LOG

- Students will be required to read for at least 30 minutes during the afternoon.
- Students MUST complete the digital reading log (GC).

CLASSLINK WORK

- Students will be assigned ONE assignment on GC per day.

Small Groups

Exact Path

How will they be used to guide student instruction?

- Exact Path software will determine an individualized Learning Path for each student based on his/her diagnostic performance.
- Student data will be analyzed by Reading Specialists and Interventionists to determine student eligibility for RTI services. You will be notified by your RTI Team of any students in your class that have been identified.

Other Information

Please do not have you child finish work that I have not yet assigned to them.

- ~ I may still need to teach it to them.
- ~ I may still need to explain/modify the directions.
- ~ I may be saving it for small group instruction.

Helpful Tip

Have students come to school each day with a little notebook to keep track of any assignments they did not finish throughout the day.

Examples-Math workbook page, Collaborative Activities, and so forth.
