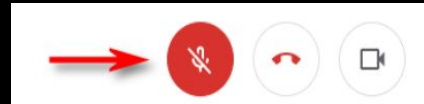


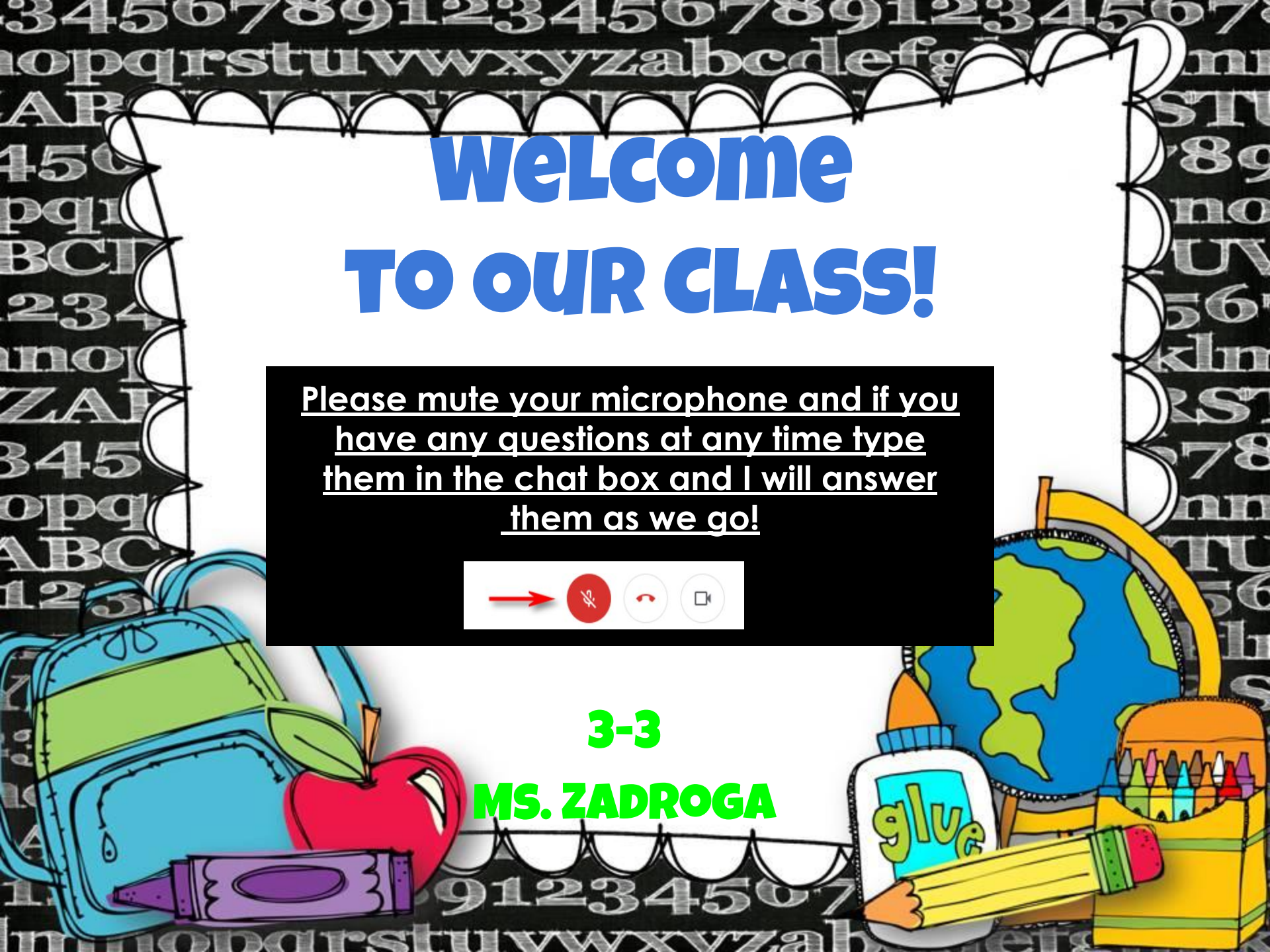

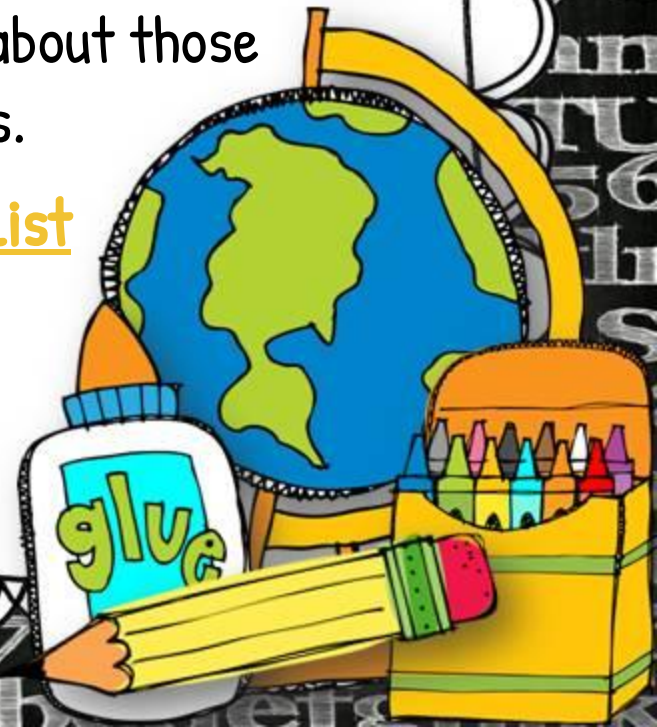

WRITING

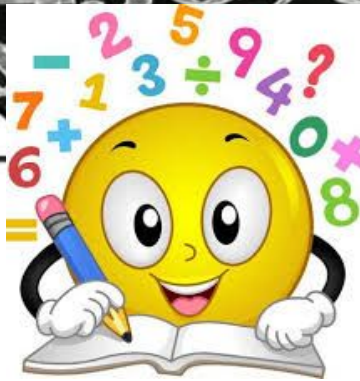
- Program used: Being a Writer
