

HELPFUL PRODUCTS – There are lots of products out there that make life easier for older adults. The following are five of the best. There's a smart pill reminder box that is programmable to make it easy to remember to take medications on time. Next is an adjustable bathtub safety grab bar, which is a really easy way to modify the bathroom without having to make any permanent changes to the home. An automatic stove shut-off can help prevent fires in the home if you forgot and left the stove on. There's a cordless fall monitor and cordless floor mat that can be placed outside or in the doorway, and it'll alert you in the event of a loved one falling. Lastly, there's an orientation clock that helps with memory loss. Google "products for seniors catalog" to find these items. You'll see a wide array of choices from which to choose, as well as free catalogs to help with special needs.

MYTHS ABOUT HOSPICE CARE – This is the first in a short series about a subject that none of us want to talk about. For that very reason, there's a misconception about its role in the care of those who are suffering from a terminal illness. There are five of these myths, some of which you'll

read about today, the rest will appear in future columns.

The first myth is that the patient must have a written referral from their doctor before they can be assessed to see if they are appropriate for hospice care. This is <u>not true</u>. A patient or their family/medical POA (Power of Attorney) can ask for an assessment by hospice at any time. This is an opportunity to learn what supports hospice can provide and to answer any questions that the patient and family may have. If the patient decides that they want to elect to use their Medicare Part A benefit for hospice, THEN the physician will need to write a referral to hospice, and a hospice nurse will be sent out to do a comprehensive assessment, explain the hospice benefits to the patient and their family, and the patient or their Medical Power of Attorney will sign the admission paperwork. (Aging Life Care Assoc.)




