Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome back! This is a challenging year but we plan on doing our best to feed our students nutritious meals.

As of September 10, 2020 Burlington Public Schools will be offering lunch for all Free/Reduced/Paid students. Lunch cost at the elementary and middle school is \$3.00 and high school is \$3.25. Once a lunch order has been received your student lunch account will be charged. Below is the outline of how lunch orders will be placed and delivered to the students.

Marshall Simonds Middle School and Elementary Schools lunch will be ordered by their homeroom teacher. Cafeteria staff will deliver the bagged lunches to elementary students before dismissal to the designated areas at their school. Marshall Simonds Middle School students will receive their bagged lunches outside of their classroom prior to their designated lunch times.

In our efforts to reduce contact and maintain distance, this year we will be using an online order form for all lunches at the Burlington High School as the pilot for future use district wide. Parents/students of the Burlington High School will be required to complete this form no later than 8 a.m. on the day of the purchase. All fields must be completed with selections for lunch. Lunches will be pre-packaged in a bag with their name on it.

9th grade orientation - Please be sure to pick up your ordered lunch outside the cafeteria.

Starting next week on Monday, September 14, 2020 students will have designated seating in the cafeteria and their pre-ordered lunch will be placed on their desk prior to their arrival.
