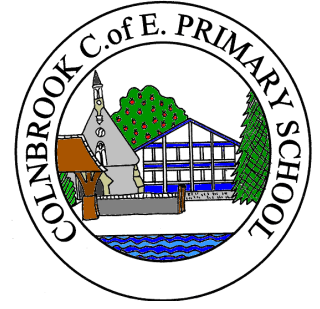

Prayer Trees

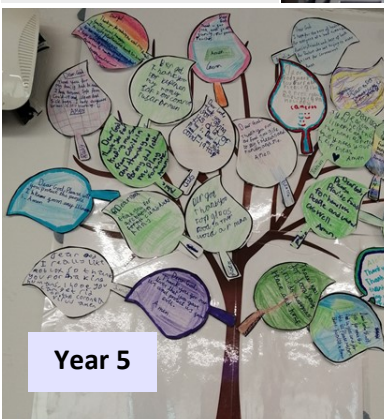
This week each year group has created a prayer tree for their classroom. They are all different and represent the children in that year. The trees will be used to carry prayers that the children may write during worship or RE.

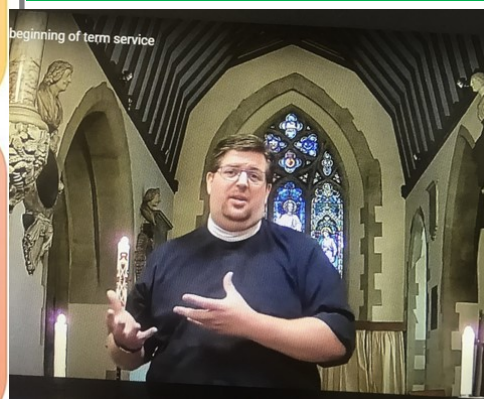
