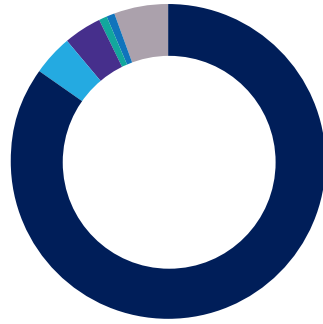

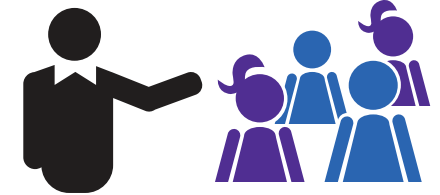

#### Early Childhood

##### Early Childhood Family Education

For parents and young children birth to 5 years, learn to play together and meet other families with young children.

##### Early Childhood Screening

Done after the child's third birthday, free check of child's health and development, required for school attendance.

##### Preschool Place 15/School Readiness

For children age three to kindergarten, a preschool program that provides a safe environment to grow and learn.

##### Just 4 Kids Childcare

A year-round, comprehensive childcare program which provides a safe, fun and nurturing environment for children three years to kindergarten.

#### Youth Programs

##### Kids Connection School-Age Childcare

A year-round, comprehensive childcare program offering a safe, fun and nurturing environment for children kindergarten to fifth grade.

##### Youth Enrichment

Courses and activities offered after school, non-school days and summer for kindergarten to eighth grade.

##### Districtwide Youth

Clubs offered to secondary students including ski and snowboard clubs, trap and fall performance danceline.

##### Driver Education

Classroom and behind the wheel instruction.

##### Youth Recreation

A variety of sports opportunities for youth preschool to grade eight.

##### Adult Basic Education

ABE provides adults with opportunities for GED test preparation, college preparation, English language skills and more.

##### Adult Enrichment and Recreation

Affordable, fun opportunities offered such as fitness, hobbies, cooking, art and more.
