

## Senior School Student Charter

## School Return September 2020

Each member of our community has a role in ensuring we keep everyone safe and keeping the running of our school as smooth as it can be. We appreciate this is going to feel rather strange at times, but if we co-operate and look out for each other we can make this work and get on with enjoying our school experience.

We cannot have any member of our community on site if they feel they cannot agree to the following charter:

- 1. I will not come to school if I or anyone in my household has any Covid-19 symptoms. I will follow the NHS / PHE guidance on testing and isolation, and keep school informed.
- 2. I will try to arrive at school within my designated drop off-times where possible.
- 3. I will enter school through my designated entry point in the morning, and I will wait at the 2m queue marks until instructed to enter.
- 4. If I have travelled by public transport and have been wearing a face mask, I will not wear it again or until it has been cleaned (if it is reusable).
- 5. I will consent to having my temperature measured when I enter, and follow instructions from staff.
- 6. I will sanitise my hands before proceeding beyond my entry point.
- 7. I will wear a face covering in communal areas around school as and when the school requests unless an exception has been agreed with the school.
- 8. I will respect that we all have the right to wear face coverings at times if we choose to and that some are unable to do so.
- 9. If I fail the temperature test I agree to leave the school site as soon as possible and to follow the DfE guidance and selfisolate for at least 10 days. I may return to school if I have not had any of the recognised symptoms of Covid-19 for the previous ten days.
- 10. If it is deemed I have been in close contact in school with someone who has tested positive I will follow the advice from the Health Protection Team and school, even if that means having to stay off school for a while
- 11. If I have been asked to self-isolate due to issues relating to Covid-19, I will make sure I keep in contact with my teachers and, if I am well enough, I will try my best to keep up with my school work remotely.
- 12. I will go straight to my allocated space and remain there at all times unless given permission by a teacher.
- 13. I will ensure that I keep within my Year group 'bubble', and keep within my designated Year group Fixed Base in school unless given permission by a teacher to move elsewhere.
- 14. When moving between rooms within my Year group Fixed Base, I will ensure that I try to keep my distance from others and will be considerate.
- 15. When I need to move beyond my Year group Fixed Base I will ensure that I follow the set route plans around school (even if that means it takes me longer to get where I need to be).
- 16. I will sanitise my hands every hour, before and after breaks, and before and after I eat my lunch, and ensure that I wash my hands thoroughly and regularly throughout the day.
- 17. I will bring my own equipment to school (stationery, calculators, water bottle, headphones, etc.) and will only use my own things. I will not share nor ask to borrow equipment from others.
- 18. I will bring my own water bottle and not share it with anyone else in any way.
- 19. I will remember to wear my PE kit (including tracksuit bottoms) on the day I have my Games afternoon.
- 20. I know that I cannot share my belongings or food with others.
- 21. I will not swap desks once I have been assigned one, and if I need to move around the classroom, I will put my hand in the air and wait until the supervising teacher says I can move.
- 22. I will maintain a 2 metre distance from teachers and staff in school wherever possible.
- 23. If I am worried about anything or I am not certain what to do, I will talk to a member of staff.
- 24. I will help aim to role model good practice, and will try to remind people around me about the importance of following these protocols.
- 25. In shared social spaces I will sanitise my hands on entry and exit, wipe down study tables before and after use, and follow instructions of staff immediately as I know these are for my own safety.
- 26. Should I feel unwell at any point whilst I am at school then I will strictly follow the advice posted in each classroom about what I should do.

I agree to adhere to the student charter listed above:
