First, thank you to the 1550+ families who came to the Materials Pick Up and School Photos Days last week! You were AWESOME!



3. Virtual Curriculum Night 2020!

We will be having our annual Curriculum Night on Thursday September 17! However, this year it will be virtual as we cannot be on campus. Here's how it will work:

- Teachers are making 5 minute videos about each of the classes they teach, including Advisory.
- ➤ We will be creating an easy-to-access table that lists each teacher alphabetically along with the classes they teach. Each class will be a hyperlink to the video for that particular class.
- ➤ Families will receive an email later this week with all the info you will need to access the table and links (we are still creating the table and links)
