#### **Important Things to Remember**

- It is really important for everyone to follow the **social distancing guidelines** to keep us all as safe as possible and to minimise the impact over the coming year
- If you have more than one child to pick up, please collect the child who finishes at the **LATEST** time first. This will also help to reduce congestion. For example, if you have a child in Reception and Year 6, you would collect the Year 6 child at 3pm from their exit door and then go to the hall where your Reception child will be waiting.
- Please be mindful of our neighbours and be careful not to block driveways
- As some of our children have nut allergies, we do not allow nuts or nut products in lunch boxes or brought into school.
- School lunches can be booked on ParentPay up to midnight the day before.
- The water fountains are out of use, so please make sure your child has plenty of water for the day.
- If you would like to speak to your child's teacher, please email the school office who will forward it on.











#### Breakfast and After school club

As you are aware from my previous letters, we are currently reviewing the wrap around care provision and aim to be able to resume this the week of September 21st. However, both clubs will be modified with limited numbers and activities to keep pupils and staff as safe as possible.

Breakfast club will be from 8:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. Toast and juice will be provided using disposable plates and cups. Numbers will be limited to 15 places for the term.

After School Club will run from 3:15 p.m. – 4:45 p.m. You will notice that these timings are modified; this is to allow for the extra cleaning / sanitising by the site team. Numbers of spaces allocated will be limited to 10. We ask that if your child is allocated a place for After School Club you provide a snack for them as well as an activity i.e colouring book and crayons, puzzle book, reading etc. No electronic games please.

To register your interest in your child having a place at either Breakfast or After School Club please send an email to office@wslprimaryacademy.org.uk with the subject line 'Breakfast Club Place' and/or 'After School Club Place'.

Please be aware that registering your interest does not automatically ensure a place as numbers are limited and preference will be given to critical key workers. Notification will be sent to you via Parentmail if we have been able to meet your request.

If a space has been allocated then you will be required to pay for the whole of term 1 through ParentPay. This is because each space must be booked and paid for in advance on a half termly basis to allow for consistent groupings in line with government guidance. Places will be reserved for the whole of term 1, although you do not need to use them every day.

Archie for his politeness this week and his fantastic attitude to learning. He has consistently remembered to raise his hand and set a great example for others. Well done for settling in so well Archie.




Doves - George

As a reminder to all parents, please find below the maps that outline the times and direction to drop off children in the mornings. Please maintain social distance.


