

Midlothian High School PSAT/NMSQT and AP Testing Procedures for Home-Schooled Students

According to Texas Education Code §29.916 a home-schooled student may attend Midlothian High School for the purpose of taking the PSAT/NMSQT assessment or an AP exam. Home-schooled students must abide by the following procedures in order to be assessed on the PSAT/NMSQT or AP exam during the regular school day at Midlothian High School:

- MUST reside within the boundaries of the Midlothian Independent School District (proof of residency required)
- Must be in the 11th grade for PSAT/NMSQT; 9th-12th for AP exams
- Must have a photo ID
- Midlothian High School must have enough materials to cover the needs of students enrolled on the campus first; home-schooled students will be permitted to test, space and materials permitting, on a first-come, first serve basis.
- Home-schooled students participating in PSAT/NMSQT or AP exam must check-in at the school's main office upon arrival and check-out upon leaving the campus.
- The home-schooled student must wear a visitor badge at all times while on campus.
- The home-schooled student must be under the direct supervision of a staff member at all times while on campus.

Midlothian High School will administer the PSAT/NMSQT October 16, 2019. Interested home-school students within MHS school boundaries should contact the campus by September 19, 2019, in order to ensure space/material availability and test registration. The fee is \$15 for the PSAT/NMSQT. We cannot guarantee availability of PSAT/NMSQT exams for homeschooled students after September 19, 2019. Registered students should plan to check in at 7:45am. Please bring your own pencils, calculator, and items needed for testing.

Midlothian High School will administer the AP exams according to the College Board [exam calendar here](#). Interested home-school students within the MHS school boundaries should contact the campus by October 31, 2019 in order to ensure space/material availability and test registration. The fee is \$95 per exam. We cannot guarantee availability of tests for homeschool students after October 31, 2019. Registered students should plan to check in on their test date(s) at 7:45am. Please bring your own pencils, pens, calculator, and items needed for testing.

College Board recommends that students contact campuses a minimum of **four months** before the test to ensure the availability of space and test materials.
