



## 2020 Sub-Varsity Football FAQs

### **What is the 2020 Sub-Varsity Football Ticket Purchase and Passes Procedure?**

- SBISD Coaches will give each sub-varsity football player two (2) passes for their parents or guardian that will be used throughout the season.
- Each pass entitles the cardholder to purchase one (1) single game ticket in SBISD – Adults \$3, Students \$1.
- Lost or stolen passes will not be replaced and are subject to confiscation if misused.

### **What is required for fans to be allowed entry to a Sub-Varsity Football game?**

- Due to limited seating, fans will not be allowed to purchase a ticket for entry for any game without the correct pass.
  - Other passes will not be accepted this year for sub-varsity football, such as: Coaches' Association Passes, Faculty ID Badge, Senior Citizen Passes or any pass used in the past.
- Passes are valid only for the contest involving the school of issue, valid only for the contest involving the sport issued, and valid only at SBISD venues unless an opponent agrees to honor the SBISD pass.
- Participation in interscholastic athletics, whether as a participant or spectator, is considered a privilege and not a right. Parents and spectators will be removed from the premises and prohibited from attending future should they exhibit objectionable behaviors and/or fail to comply with all SBISD, UIL and TEA COVID-19 guidelines.

### **What Health and Safety Protocols will be in Place for Football Games?**

The following procedures related to SBISD football, based on the public health situation as we understand it today, applies to the 2020 season. These procedures are effective immediately. Changes to the public health situation in the coming months may necessitate changes to these procedures.

- All UIL, TEA and SBISD COVID-19 guidelines, policies, and procedures will be followed to ensure the health, safety and well-being of our students, staff and families.
- All employees, parents, visitors, students, and children three years of age or older must wear face masks or face coverings in alignment with the LearnSBISD Plan upon entry to an area where UIL activities are being conducted and when not actively practicing or playing in a contest.
- We may need to clear the bleachers between games depending on the venue. We encourage parents and players to exit immediately after their game.
